In compliance with the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) requirements, the City of San Juan will conduct a public hearing to solicit input from interested parties on the city's proposed Budget and Program Amendment to its Urban County Program Years 22 & 23 (2009 & 2010).

The public hearing will be held on Tuesday April 12th at 6:00 P.M at San Juan's Fire Station No. 2 - Commissioner's Room, located on 2301 N. Raul Longoria Rd in San Juan, Texas 78589.

The following is the proposed budget & program amendment for your consideration:

The proposed Budget and Program Amendment will **TRANSFER** the surplus funding from the sidewalk improvements activity in the amount of \$44,104.45 and will **CREATE** a water/sewer improvements activity in the amount of \$44,104.45 to assist with the environmentally cleared water/sewer improvements project located on Oblate Street and downtown alleyways, approved in Program Years 19 & 21 (2006 & 2008).

The proposed Budget and Program Amendment will **DELETE** the street improvements activity in the amount of \$257,203.00 and will create two new projects:

PROJECT A) a water/sewer improvements activity in the amount of \$30,895.55 to assist with the environmentally cleared water/sewer improvements project located on Oblate Street and downtown alleyways, a continued project with funding in Program Years 19 & 21 (2006 & 2008).

PROJECT B) a water/sewer improvements activity located along the alley between Standard, Lincoln, Nebraska and 8th through 11th street in the amount of \$226,307.45.

This correspondence is to respectfully request that funding allocated to the City of San Juan be amended as follows:

Funding Available:

\$257,203.00 – 2010 Street Improvements
+\$ 44,104.45 – 2009 Sidewalk Improvements surplus
\$301,307.45 – total available to be amended

Breakdown of Amendment:

\$ 75,000.00 – to be transferred into 06/08 Water & Sewer Improvements (Oblate St. & alleyways)
+\$226,307.45 – to be transferred into new 2010 Water & Sewer Improvements (Nebraska Ave.
\$301,307.45 /Lincoln Ave. and alleyways)

This transfer of funds should allow the City to have adequate funding to proceed with proposed water and sanitary sewer project for downtown San Juan.
