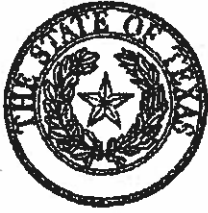

Re: Tracking Canine Program

The Segovia Unit, Texas Department of Criminal Justice Correctional Institution utilizes the services of tracking canines for the pursuit of escaping offender, and for providing assistance to local law enforcement agencies. It is also a very important tool that acts as a deterrent for security purposes and to preserve the safety of our communities. The Segovia Unit has a kennel Sergeant assigned, responsible for supervising the care, training, and use of the canine teams. Offender workers assigned to the tracking canine programs are State-approved outside trustees who have volunteered for these assignments. Because our canines must regularly run "tracks" on routes pre-established by the kennel Sergeant, we are continuously looking for open areas and depend on the generosity of our community in facilitating us with the use of their properties in which to conduct this essential training. The Kennel Sergeant will accompany the canine team along the route from beginning to the end and is responsible for the safety of the canine team and Offender releasing you of all liabilities. We appreciate your consideration of this request and your role in maintaining of this effective and productive training canine program.
