RESOLUTION HONORING THE 35TH ANNIVERSARY OF
FREDDY GONZALEZ ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WHEREAS, on May 27, 1975, the Edinburg School Board voted unanimously in favor of naming a new elementary in commemoration of local fallen Marine Corp Sergeant Alfredo "Freddy" Gonzalez who was awarded the highest award for bravery that can be given to an individual in the United States of America - the CONGRESSIONAL MEDAL OF HONOR (posthumously) on October 31, 1969; and
