Dear NCDA Member:

As you are aware, the current negative economic climate has produced reductions in many federal programs which impact low and moderate income families. Earlier this year, NCDA led the fight against the 62.5% cut to CDBG which was adopted by the House in bill H.R. 1. The final budget deal for FY11 produced a 16.2% cut to CDBG. While this cut is still unacceptable, it is because of our collective efforts that we were able to limit these draconian cuts to CDBG and other key HUD programs. We are now focused on the FY12 budget and NCDA will continue its advocacy for program funding in the year ahead; fighting for level funding for CDBG, HOME, HUD's homeless assistance programs, and other critical areas.

NCDA is the premier organization for **CDBG Training**; providing its nationally recognized CDBG Basics Course to community development practitioners and launching its newly developed Advanced CDBG Course for community development managers. NCDA has also successfully launched its Basics HOME Course this year.

Your membership within NCDA also provides you with **the opportunity to network with hundreds of community development professionals** through the NCDAonline Forum - an interactive listerv that allows members to communicate directly on community development issues. Members also network and learn through NCDA's annual and winter conferences, which provide a forum for hearing from and communicating with top-level HUD officials, congressional staff, leaders in the field of community development, and grantees.
