The proposed amendment will **DELETE** the street improvements activity in the amount of \$55,000.00 and **INCREASE** the parks, recreational facility improvements activity in the amount of \$55,000.00 for fencing and park equipment at Military, Municipal and Tabasco Park located in the City of La Joya.

The total amount proposed for the parks, recreational facility improvements activity is \$89,011.00.
