Community Transformation Grants (CTGs) are authorized under The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 for state and local governmental agencies, tribes and territories, and national- and community-based organizations.

The CTGs will support the implementation, evaluation, and dissemination of evidence-based community preventive health activities to reduce chronic disease rates, prevent the development of secondary conditions, address health disparities, and develop a stronger evidence base for effective prevention programming.



National Network

The National Dissemination and Support for Community Transformation Grants (CTG) Funding Opportunity Announcement referred to as the **National Network**, will support a network of community-based organizations as authorized under The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010.

These national networks will support the efforts of the Community Transformation Grants program by funding national networks of community-based organizations to disseminate and provide for the replication of successful program models and activities.
