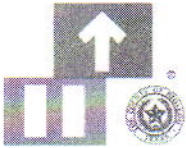

Article V, Section 1 B. "Five (5) of the members, who shall be known as the Community Representatives, shall be recommended by the Commissioners' Court (Grantee Board) and subject to approval by the Policy Council elected parents."

Article V, Section 6. "The terms of office for all Policy Council members shall be one (1) year, Mid October to Mid October, or until the new Policy Council member is formally installed, as per Article V, Section 3, Policy Council members, Alternates and Community Representatives terms shall be limited to nor more than three (3) years. Terms shall be limited to no more than three (3) years in any combination of service, whether Alternate, Parent Representative or Community Representative and terms need not be held in consecutive years."
