Dear Chief Silveira;

In support of Operation Stonegarden 2009, the La Joya Police Department is requesting to allocate it's awarded funding for the purchases of two Police Chevrolet Tahoes. Our fleet vehicles need to be replaced, due to them having high mileage and not being dependable. These vehicles purchased with Operation Stonegarden funding will provide better-equipped vehicles in support of Operation Stonegarden.

The Department has been awarded a total of \$ 86,618.52. That amount is divided as followed: \$52,669.12 for the purchase of equipment, \$28,663.80 for personnel overtime, \$3,720.56 for fringe benefits and \$1,565.04 for fuel mileage.


The Department is requesting to allocate \$7,973.80 from the personnel overtime, \$25.32 from fringe benefits and \$331.76 from fuel mileage over to the purchase of equipment. This will give a total of \$61,000 towards the purchase of equipment, which will be used to purchase and retrofit two new Police Chevrolet Tahoes. The remaining amounts of \$20,690.00 will utilized for personnel overtime, 3695.24 for fringe benefits and \$1,233.28 for fuel mileage.

Our participation in the Stonegarden Operation will be by maintaining high visibility, provide proactive law enforcement patrols, with our main intent to deter, detect and interdict human/narcotic smugglers and terrorists, all related to Border Security. These Chevrolet Tahoes will allow the officers to patrol both unpaved and paved roads, which will cover more routes that a regular patrol vehicle may not be able to travel due to the terrain. The Chevrolet Tahoes will also allow officers to patrol roads, which lead to the main corridor of the Rio Grande Valley, Expressway 83, to all human and narcotic smuggling routes.

We request this amendment to be granted for the purchase of the two new Tahoes. Let us thank you in advance for your consideration and time.
