Honorable Judge and Commissioners:

The Hidalgo County Elections Department has worked meticulously and unwavering in preparing the proposed voting election precinct changes that will be presented today. Each existing precinct was studied and each new precinct was designed by considering new County Commissioner boundaries, Constable/Justices of the Peace boundaries, city boundaries, school boundaries, water and drainage boundaries, South Texas College boundaries as well as all jurisdictional boundaries such as Congressional, State Senate and Representative and State Board of Education. This additional work was long, difficult and tedious, and my staff and I are proud to present the proposed changes. (Please note that as of Friday, December 9, 2011, the Congressional, State Senate and State House have a "stay" imposed by the Supreme Court.)

The main reasons for the proposed changes are as follows:

- The need to split precincts because of new Commissioner boundary lines;
- The population growth of Hidalgo County by over 36% within the last ten years;
- The need to change boundary lines due to annexations;
- Voter ease and clarity in understanding which precinct represents which political subdivision;
- Distinct boundaries to assist in identifying the different voting possibilities when various elections are running simultaneously;
- Voting result reports being improved because of more precision when results are calculated because of distinct precinct boundaries;

Although not all precincts were split exactly, the county, as a whole, will now be cleaner and clearer to the voter. There will still be areas, though, where perhaps one precinct, for example, may represent a partial city and a partial school, resulting in certain precincts having to share precinct numbers with various political entities. These particular precincts will not be as distinct as those we were able to split.


Two areas in Hidalgo County were not able to be changed: the city of Weslaco and South Texas College. The city of Weslaco will not vote on their single member city

district changes until later this month, but the deadline for this court to make a decision on the voting precincts is today, so we had to proceed in presenting the voting precinct changes. Also, South Texas College is waiting for recommendations from a legal standpoint as to how to proceed with any changes they may have. Changes in these two political entities may result in either coming back to this court at the end of the month to vote on more changes, or perhaps waiting for the next opportunity in 2013 to submit changes to the Department of Justice.

An increase in number of precincts does not increase the number of voters, does not increase the number of poll locations, or increase spending during elections. What it does mean is each voter will now be better represented by their voter precinct and will have a better understanding of their jurisdictional lines.

Thank you for your continued support and your understanding of the significance and importance of today's vote.
