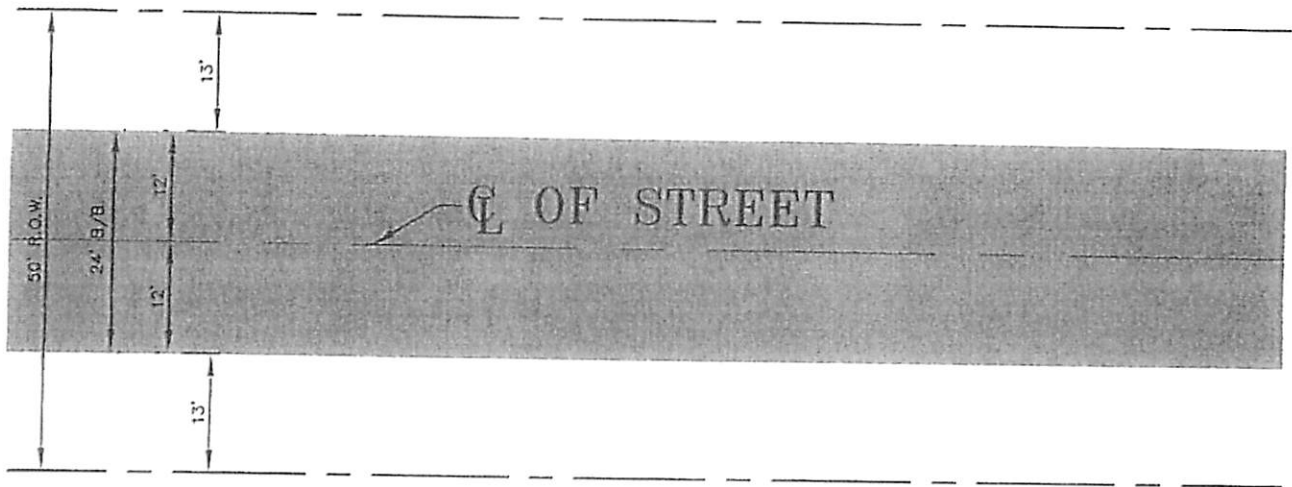

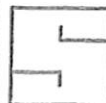
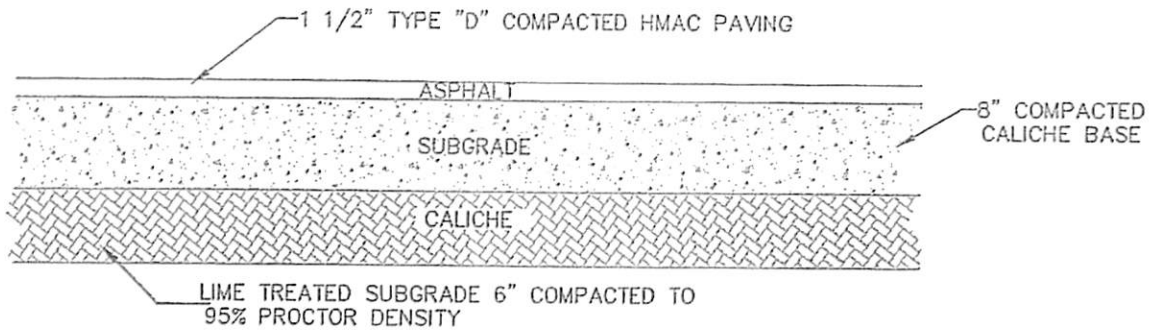

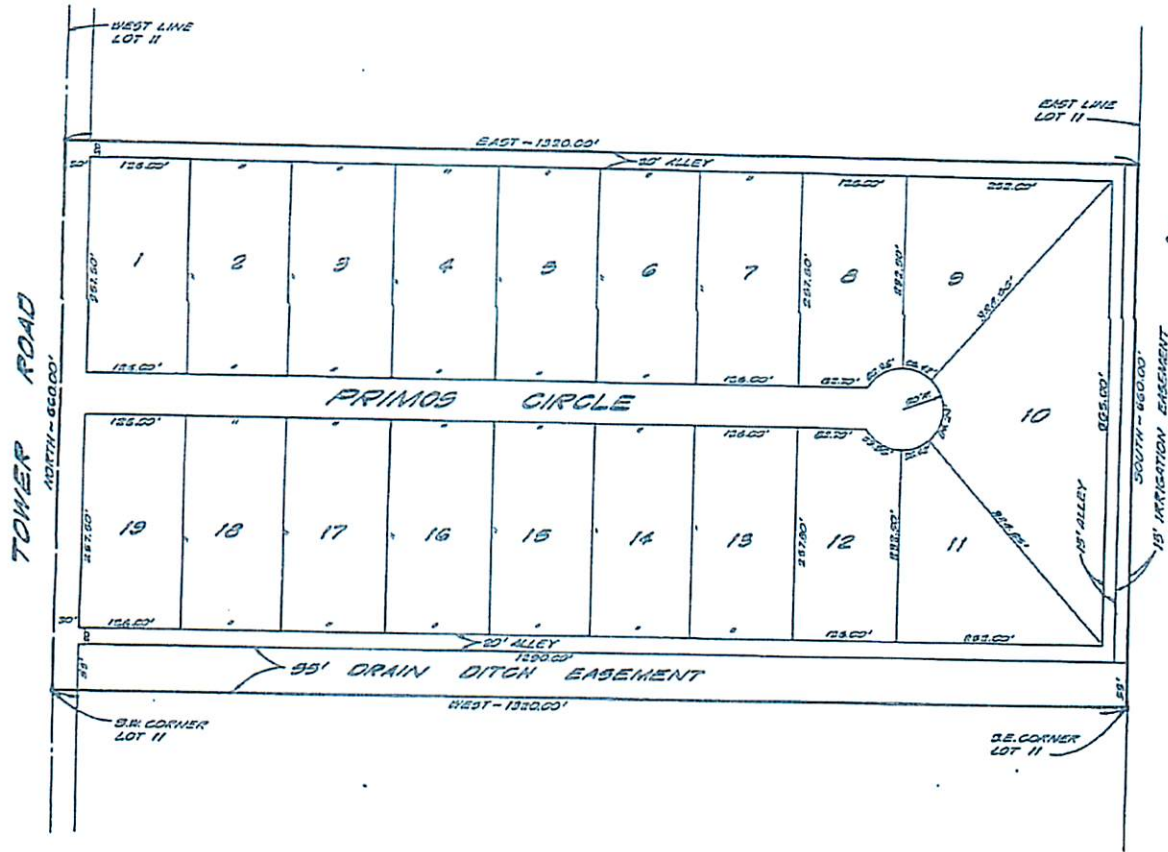

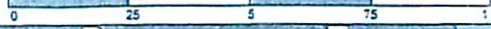


GREEN VALLEY ACRES - PRIMO CIRCLE - WESTBOUND VIEW - .25 MI

Dear Mr. Foster:

The Edinburg Consolidated Independent School District serves residents in the colonias identified on the attached - Exhibit A 1&2.

The district is responsible for the transportation of the children living in these colonias to and from their respective schools throughout our district. Road conditions in these areas limit the ability of our transportation personnel to have access to the children's homes in these colonias creating a hardship on these families to get their children to school.

Currently the public streets near these colonias serve as bus routes whereby our buses can maneuver. The areas that are not accessible have no bus transportation service. If the roadways are improved, our bus routes would extend into the colonias. The paving of roadways in these colonias would greatly enhance our capability to serve the children living in these areas.
