Description of Work Proposed

The [La Milpa Subdivision \(EDAP #M1080388\)](#) project consists of approximately [790](#) l.f. of [repaving](#) with a proposed typical road section of [6](#) inches of caliche base and 1.5 inches of asphalt or as determined through geotechnical soil tests. Project also includes associated drainage with [road side ditches](#) and all necessary appurtenances.

Colonia [La Milpa Subdivision](#) consists of [1](#) interior road(s) and approximately [790](#) l.f. inadequately paved road that contributes in inadequate drainage and limited access to the Colonia Residents. Please refer to the photograph on **Attachment C** that further illustrate the need and conditions of the Colonia Road

The proposed project involves paving of [Fresno](#) Road(s). The proposed project provides the Colonias Residents necessary access to [Mile 6 North](#) a paved County Road. Please Refer to **Attachment D and E** that illustrates the Colonias location and access.

The Proposed Project is in a proposed school bus route or maybe considered for a future bus route. Please Refer to **Attachment F**.

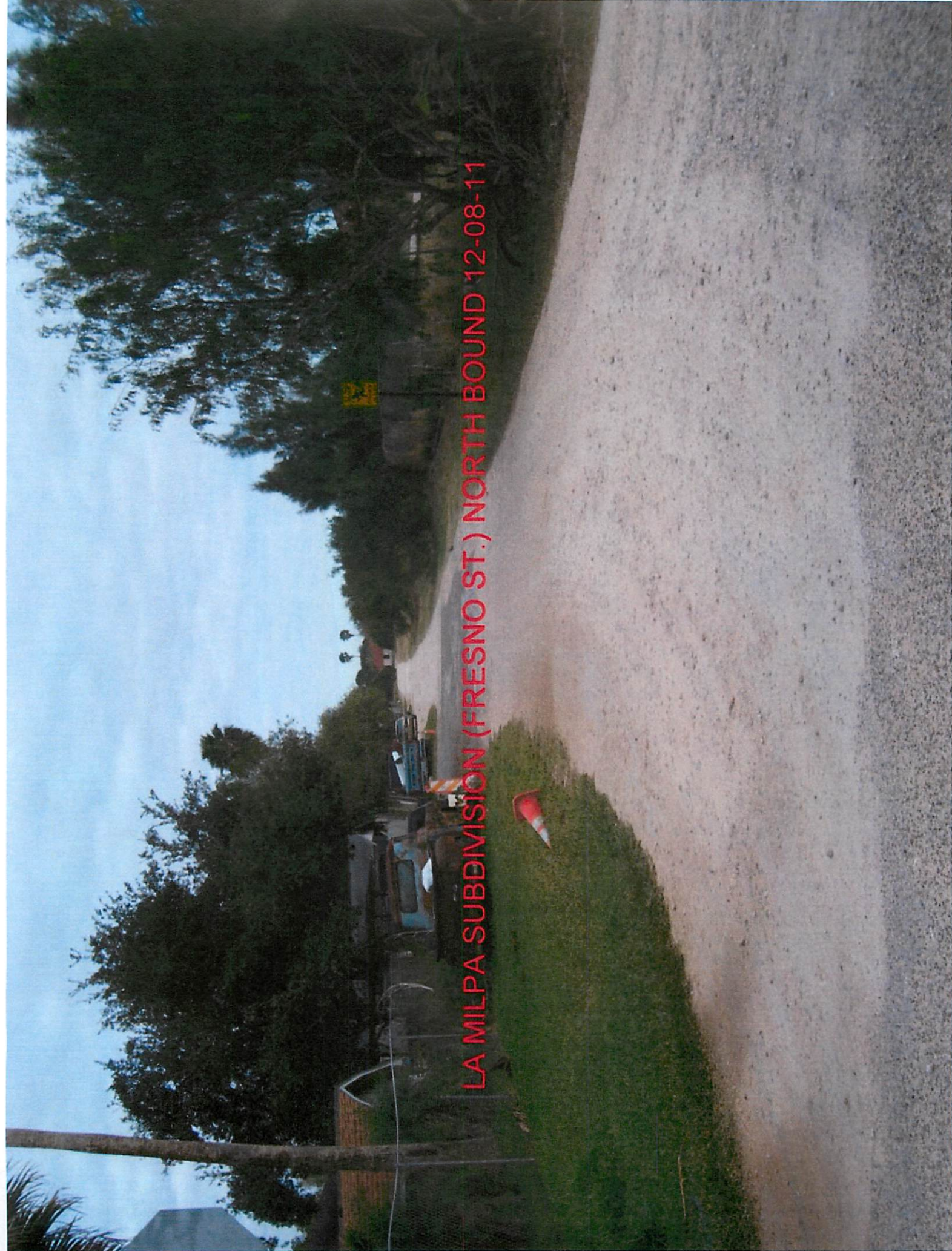

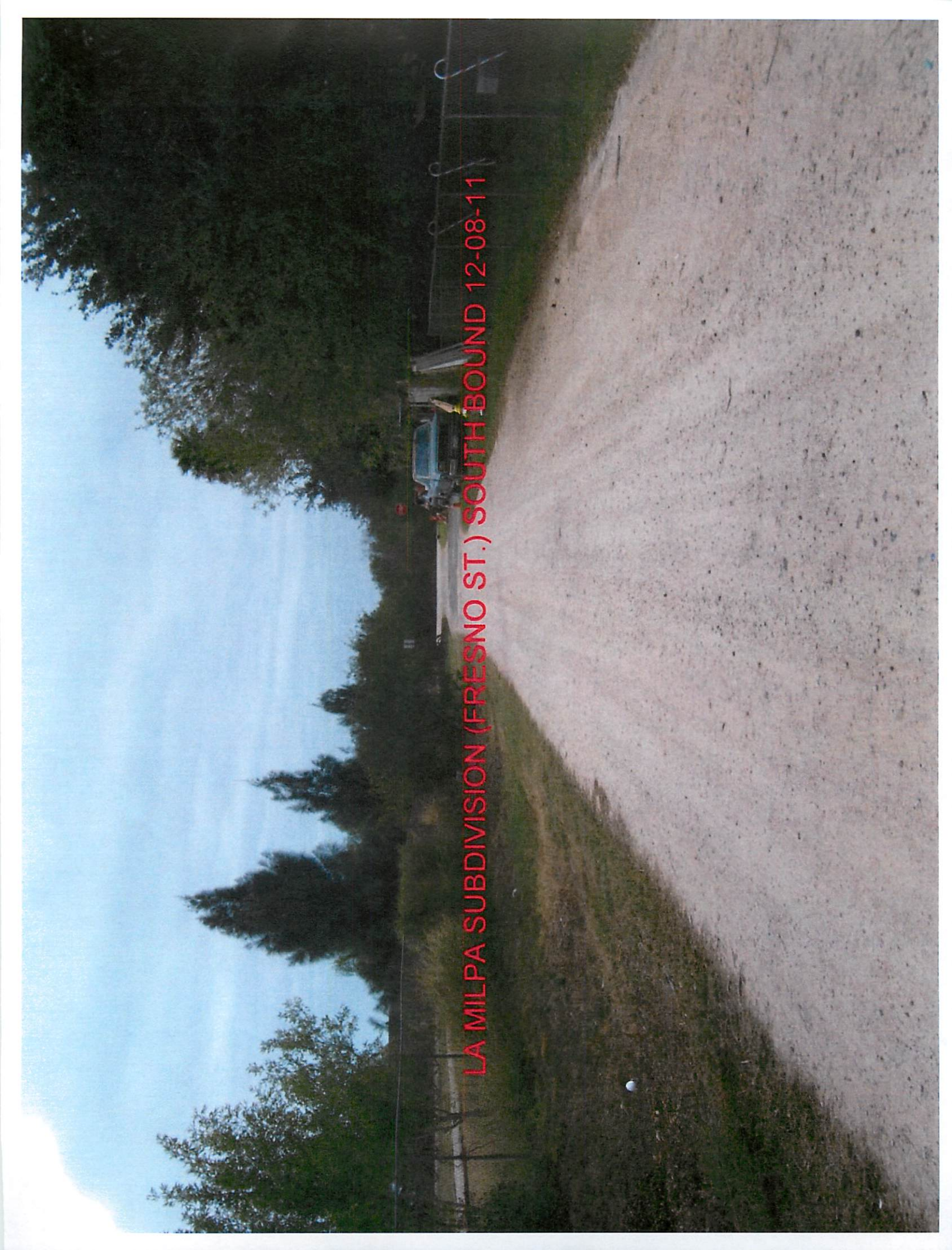


Fresno Street (La Milpa Subdivision)

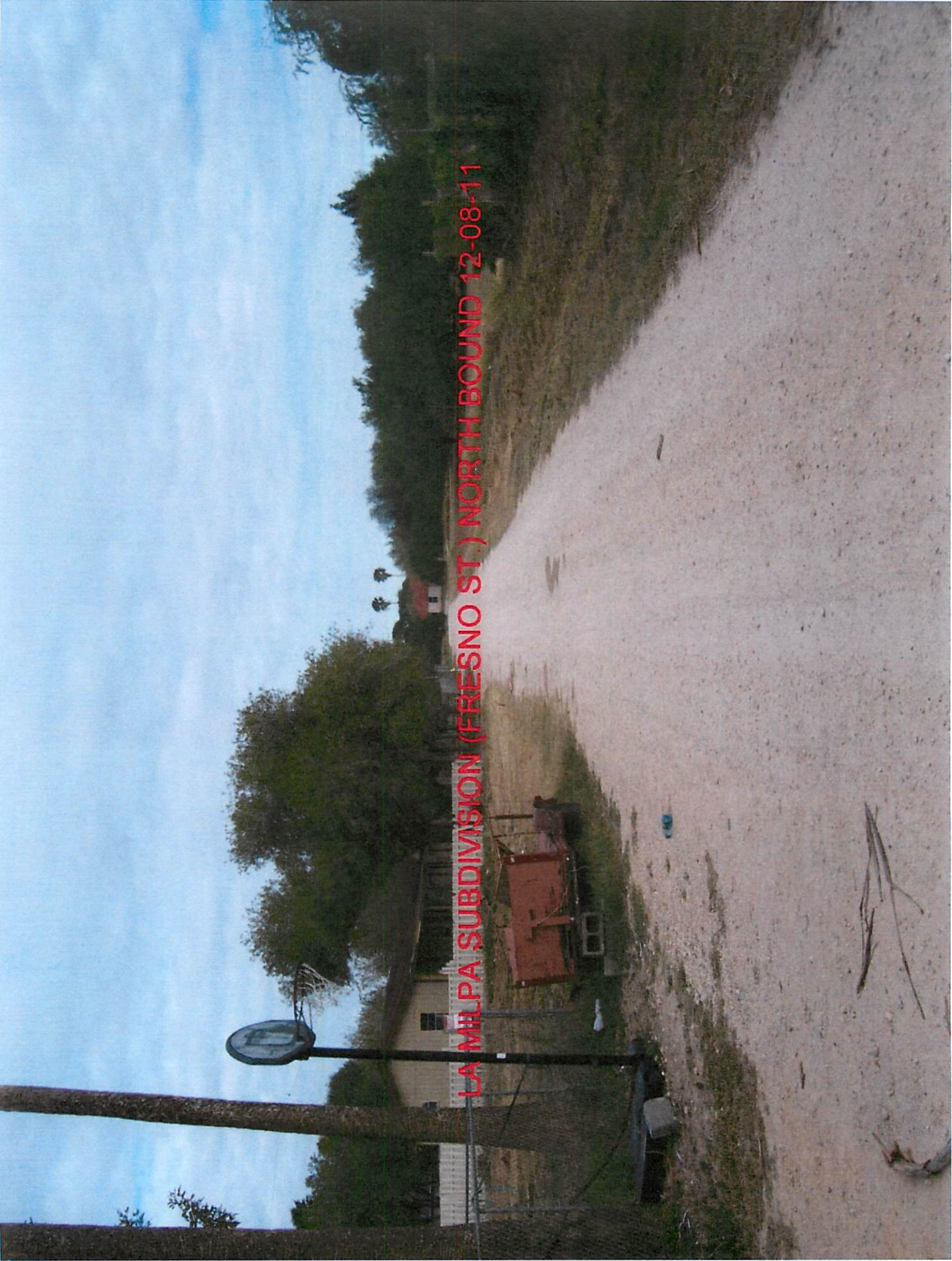
LA MILPA SUBDIVISION (FRESNO ST.) NORTH BOUND 12-08-11



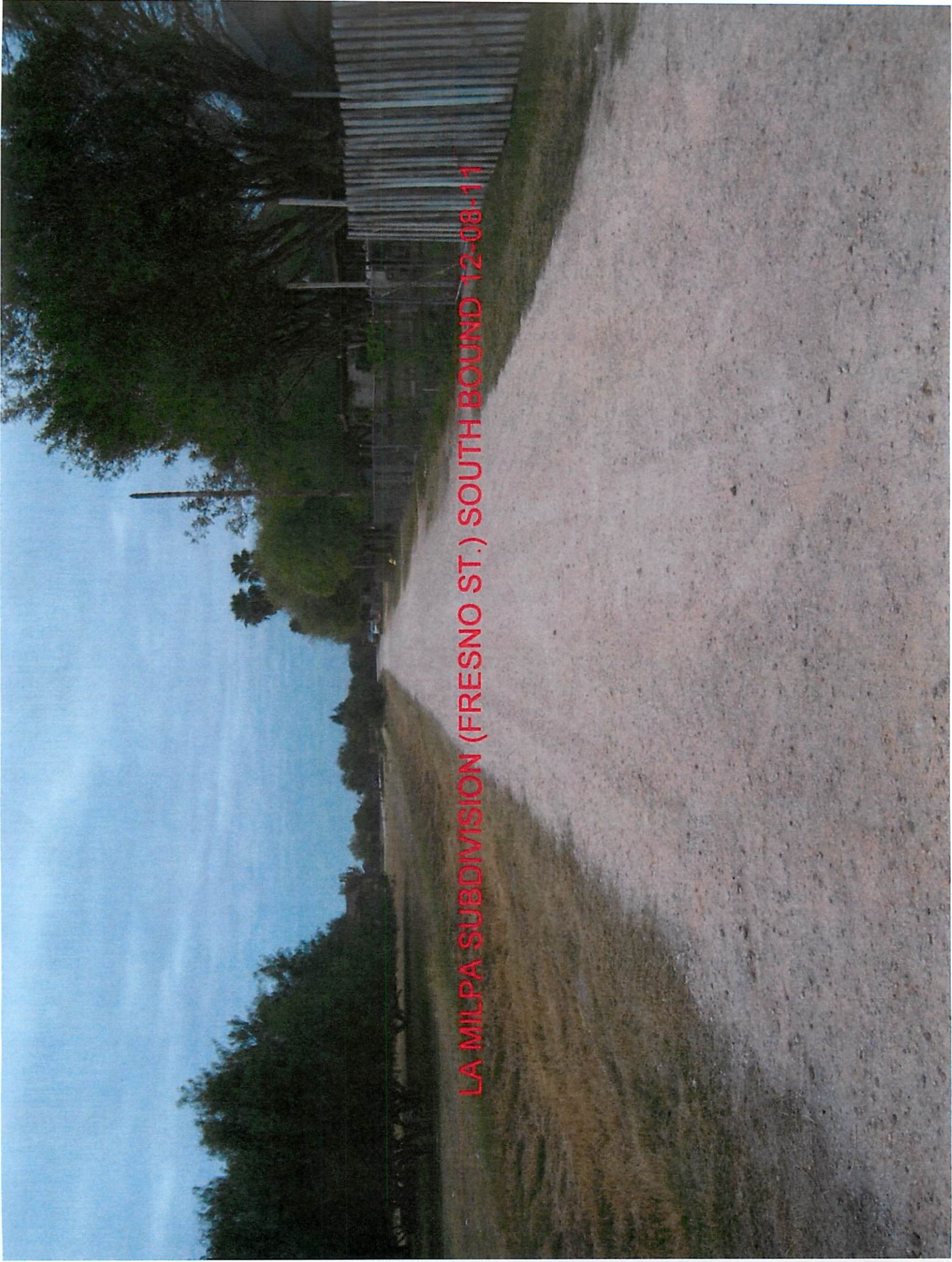
LA MILPA SUBDIVISION (FRESNO ST.) SOUTH BOUND 12-08-11



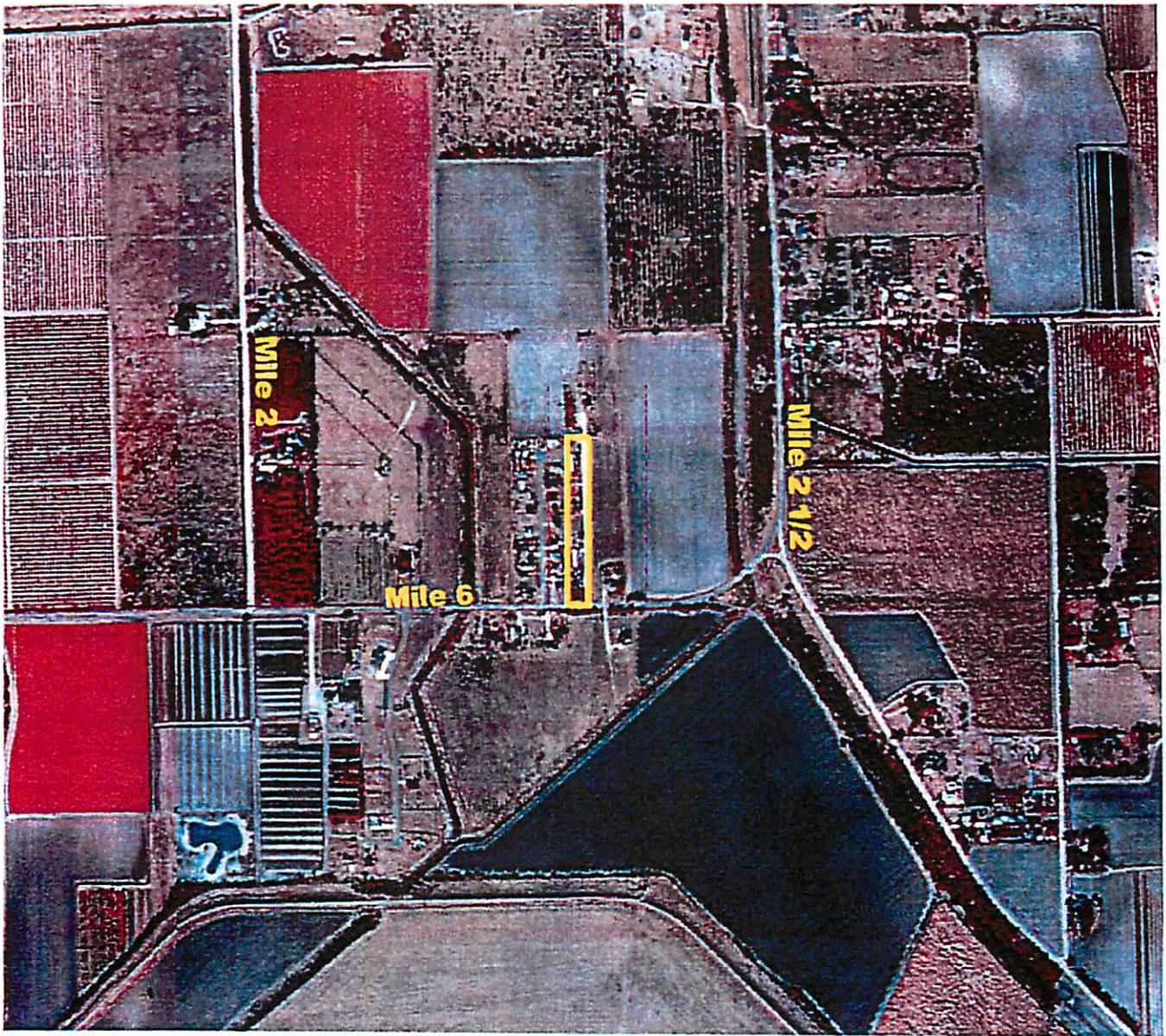

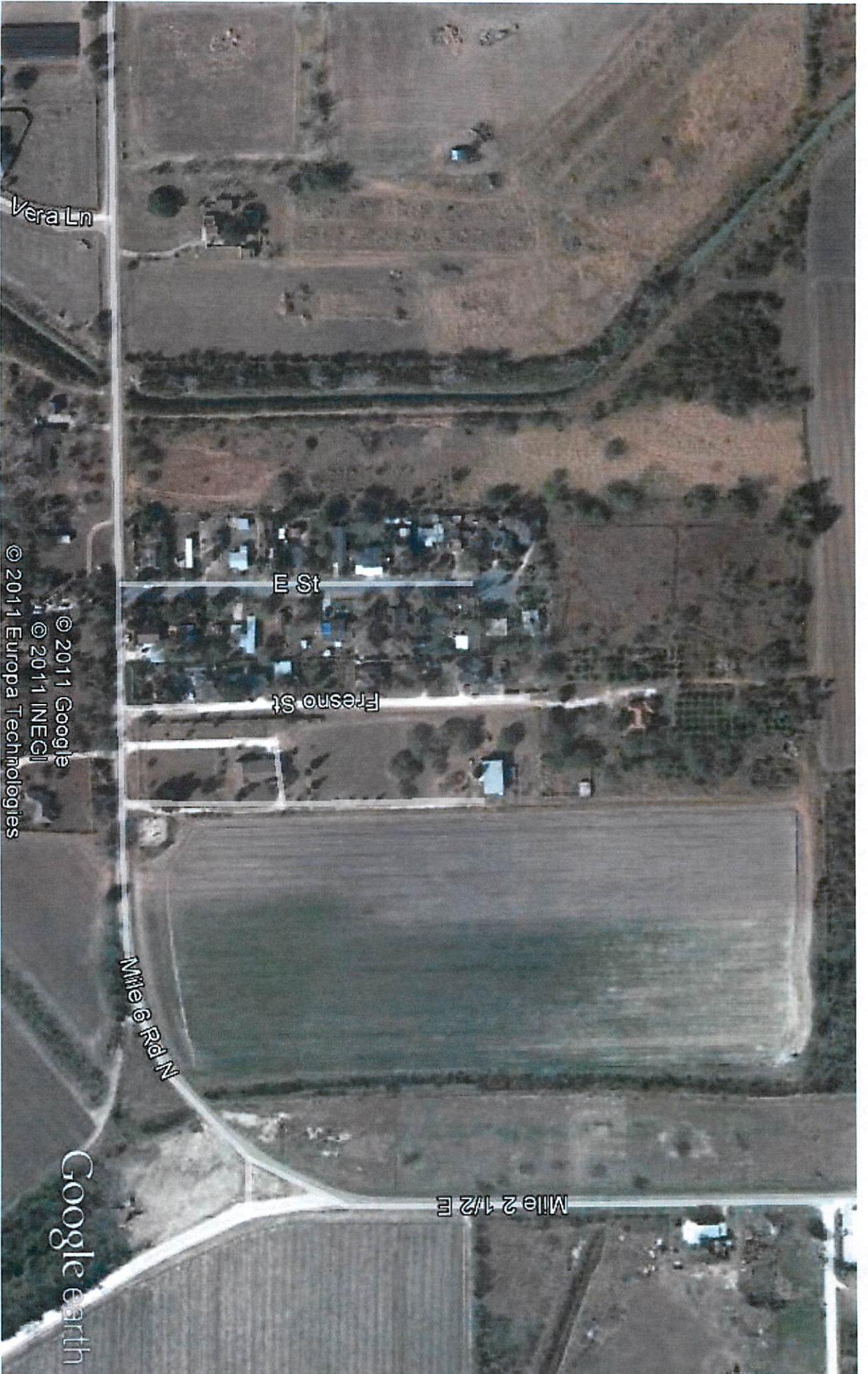

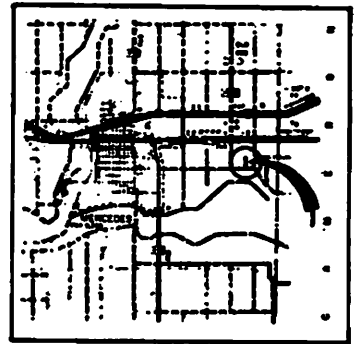

Our school district serves the following residents in the colonias identified below:



This district is responsible for the transportation of the children of these colonias to and from their respective schools throughout our District. Road conditions in these colonias limit the ability of our transportation personnel to reach the children of the colonias, creating a hardship on these families to get their children to school.

Currently the public streets in these colonias serve as bus routes where our buses can maneuver. Those areas that our buses are not accessible are not served, but if the roadways are improved our bus routes would extend into the colonias to serve the children of the area. The paving of roadways in the above identified colonias would greatly enhance and expand our capability to serve the children of the colonias.
