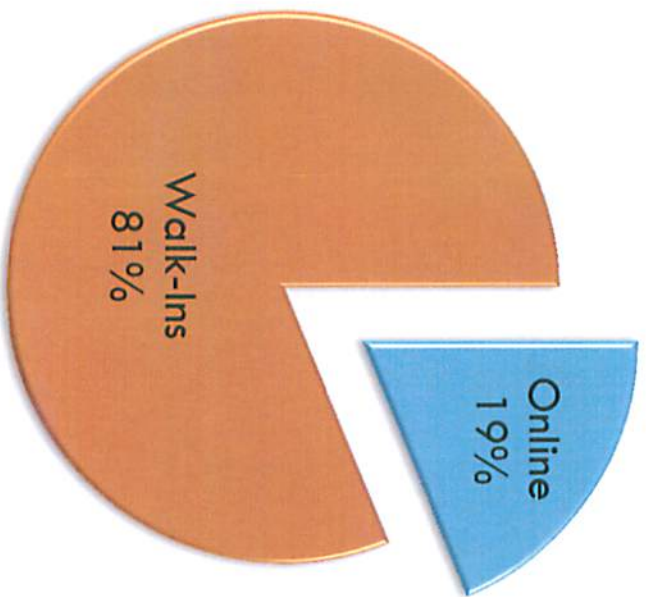

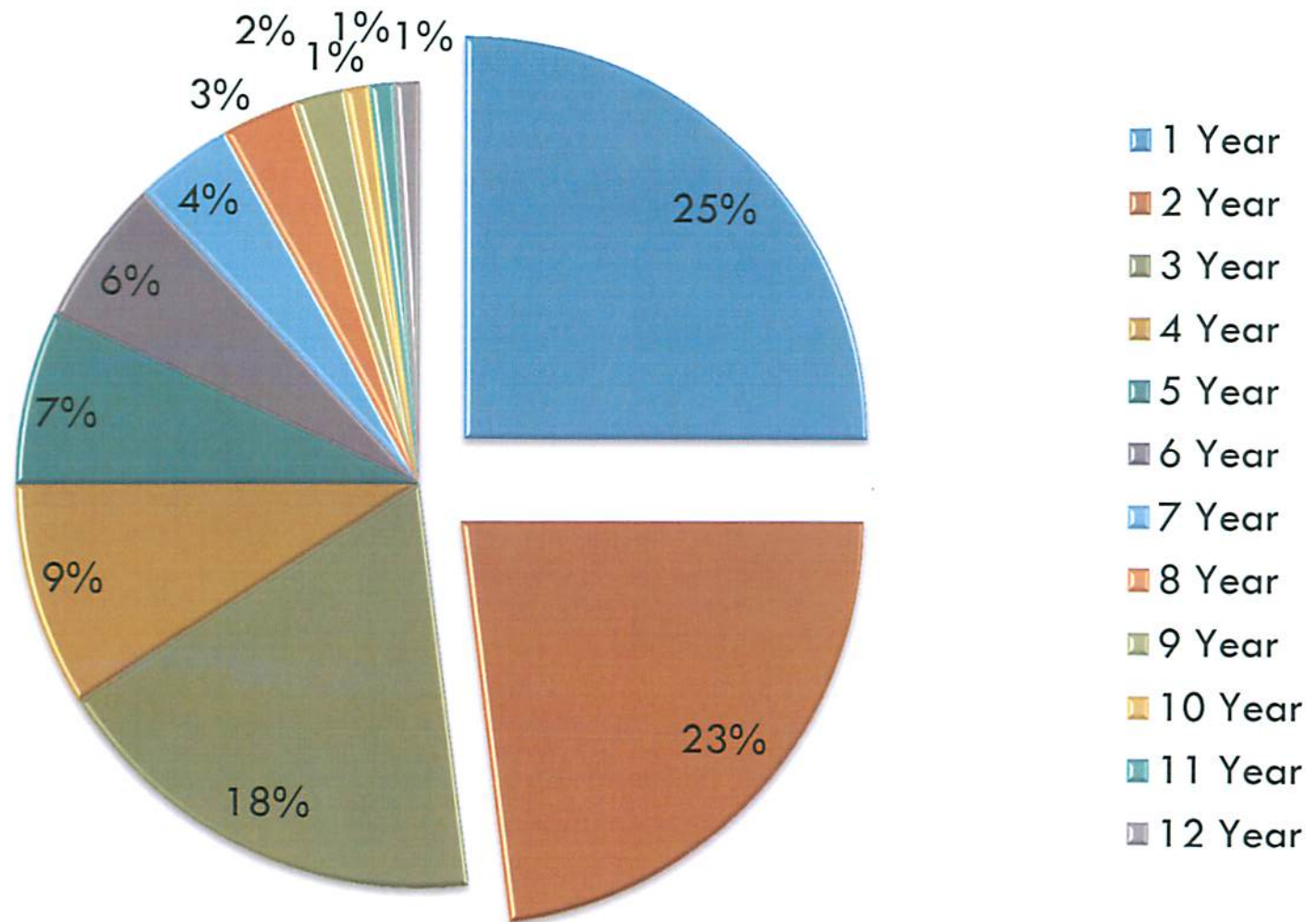
Operation Clean Slate

Operation Clean Slate Collections Aging Analysis

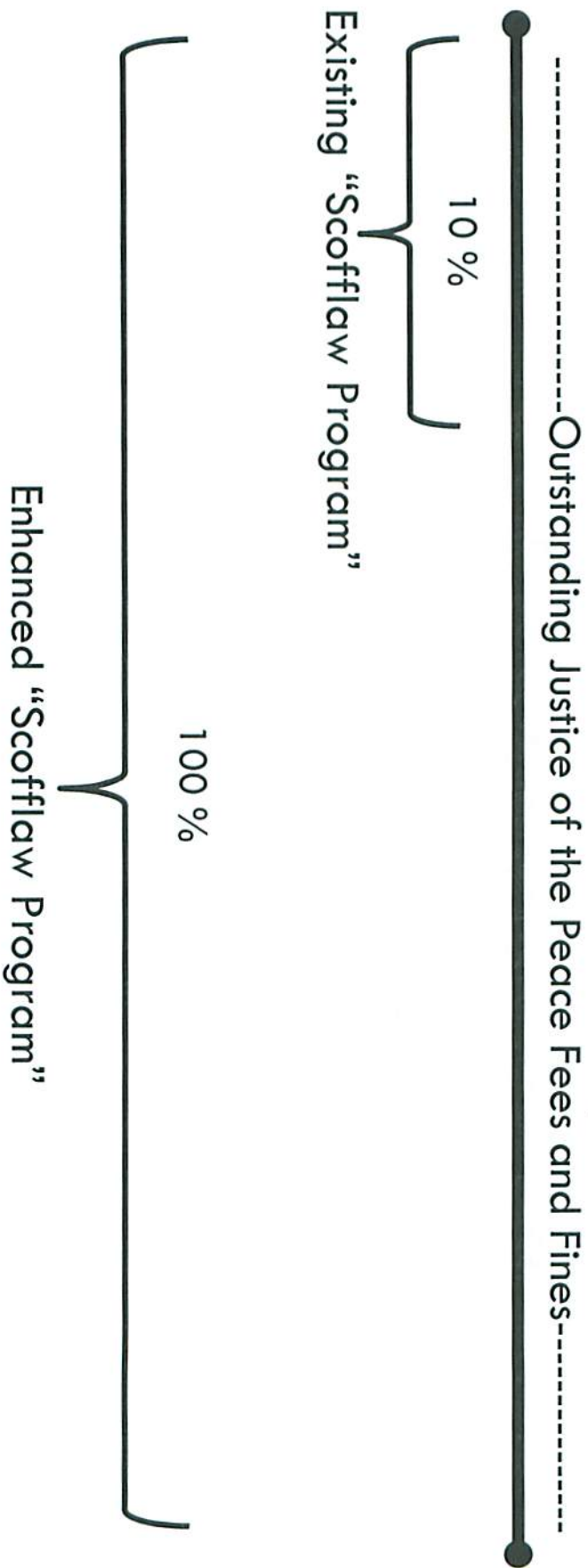


Lessons Learned

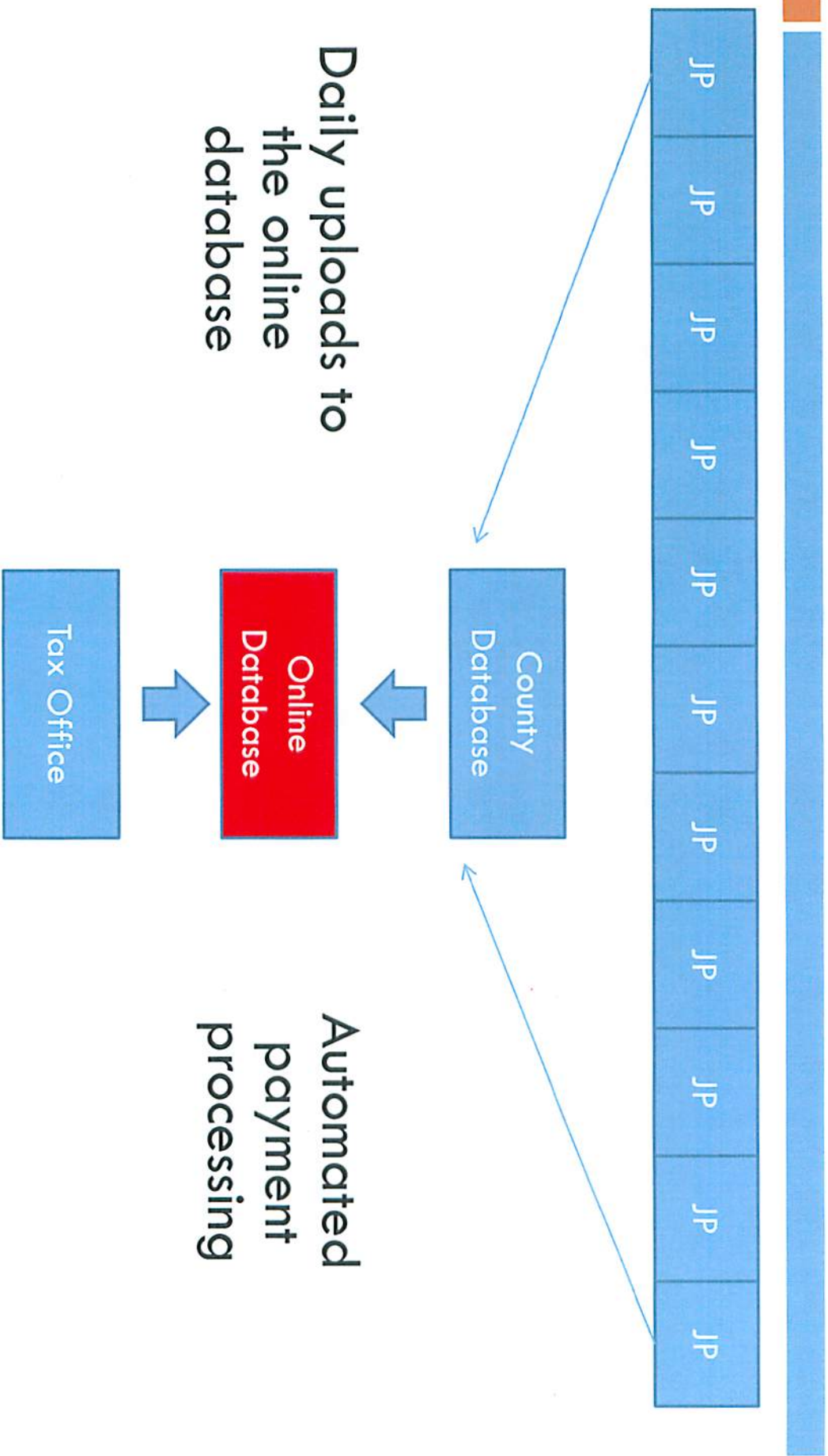


1. Utilization of technology has proven effective in increasing Justice of the Peace revenues.
2. 50% of JP revenues are attributed to cases less than 24 months old.
3. Existing TxDMV “Scofflaw Program” is limited.

Summary of Significant Events



- Commenced the online payment portal.
- Developed a master query of JP outstanding fees and fines.
- Received program approval from the District Attorney.
- Received program approval from the Tax Assessor Collector
- Conducted 4 data verification workshops with JP offices.
- Conducted live demonstrations of DL readers.

Anticipated Timeline



- February – Complete daily JP case file uploads
 - Complete the JP payment automation
 - Procure necessary equipment
