

SYNOPSIS / ACTIONS

On May 28, 2010 I Deputy Mario Cavazos was called to mile 1.5 west and mile 11 north at the Mercedes main collection site in Mercedes Texas in reference to a burglary of building. On arrival contact was made with Mr. Joe Burgos, a Hidalgo County Pct 1 employee, who reported that during the night of May 27, 2010 between the hours of 5:00pm to 7:00am May 28, 2010 an unknown person(s) entered by force into the south welding/tire shop and took items without consent of anyone. The person(s) gain entry by breaking the locking device to the eastside external metal door and then broke the locking device of an internal metal door that went into the room where the items were stored. The tool used appeared to have cut into the locking devices damaging the doors. Suspect(s) unknown. No evidence recovered.
 Item taken: (1) post digger auger - \$600.00, (2) post saw - \$150.00.
 Items Damaged, (1) 2 Metal doors - \$100.00 ea, (2) security camera system - \$150.00
 Total estimate value loss - \$1100.00

- This is the sixth time the pavilion is broken into
- Last night someone tried to kick in the aluminum on the south side bay door but they were unable because they had to screw 2x4's from a previous break in.
- The individuals climbed to the roof and broke in through the roof on the south side.
- The upstairs room is locked from the outside so they had to break through the wall to get down stairs.
- Then they broke the lock of the east bay door.
- They took a grasshopper riding lawn mower (model 5015) valued at \$700.00 and a battery off a Steiner lawn mower valued at \$100.00
- They dragged the lawn mower out of the pavilion because it can't be turned so easily.
- They broke the lock of the south side gate and they took the locks
- He does not know who broke in, but he thinks a former employee named Velasquez may be responsible
