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

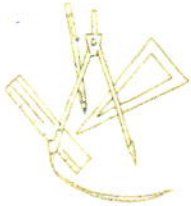

As your Technical Representative for the Hidalgo County MPO and to provide you with a monthly HCRMA update, attached for your use and information, is the HCRMA Meeting Agenda(s) for the meeting(s) held on Thursday February 1, 2012 at 5:30 p.m. We have reviewed the agenda items that were discussed as they relate to Hidalgo County and we provide the following progress report.

#### 4 REPORTS:

- A. HCRMA Roadway System Projects – Godfrey Garza, Administrative and Managerial Consultant / Louis Jones, Dannenbaum Engineering Corporation

The GEC reported that surveying and Right-of-Entry services on the Trade Corridor Connector (TCC-west project) project are on schedule. See Tab 1 for a map of RMA projects. Currently, work on the environmental document for the TCC has been suspended pending the completion and approval of the "Strategic Plan."

- B. Update on Project Finance – Richard Ramirez/Troy Madres, First Southwest

No update was given.

- C. Update on Pass Through Projects – Jody Ellington, TxDOT

Jody Ellington of TxDOT reported that \$34.7 million in pass through funds are still available from TxDOT for the La Joya Bypass Project pending successful negotiations and approval by the HCRMA, however a TxDOT minute order has not been approved.

- D. Update on Lease Agreement with City of Pharr – Dan Rios, Legal Counsel

No update was given.

- 5 ACTION ITEMS: DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION – Godfrey Garza, Administrative and Managerial Consultant / Louis Jones, Dannenbaum Engineering Corporation
- A. Discussion on administrative contracts for the Hidalgo County Loop System and the Hidalgo County Roadway System (Loop plus La Joya)

Dannenbaum reported they are near completion of the review of all the HCRMA's technical documentation from previous engineering and environmental work. This data has been used to develop the Strategic Plan which outlines different options for environmental clearance, engineering, and the purchase of Right-of-Way (ROW) for RMA projects.

This plan was presented at the January 12, 2012 RMA Workshop. Public feedback was received from elected officials concerned with the timeline for the development of the different RMA projects (see Tab 2). The main concern was not to transfer construction funding from the TCC and other RMA projects to other projects within Hidalgo County. Mr. Jones reported that additional strategies will be looked at and additional stakeholder input is needed.

Currently the RMA has \$112 Million in TxDOT Pass Through funds and approximately \$22 million in MPO funds. An Executive Summary of the plan was presented and is attached as Tab 3.

Mr. Jones also reported a call for projects for the TIGER III program. He recommended that HDR begin the completion of an application for one of the RMA projects, to be determined. Due to the short timeline for the application process, HDR would need to begin work under the GEC contract prior to approval of a new contract at the next RMA board meeting.

As your Technical Representative for the Hidalgo County MPO and to provide you with a monthly HCRMA update, attached for your use and information, is the HCRMA Meeting Agenda(s) for the meeting(s) held on Wednesday February 22, 2012 at 5:30 p.m. We have reviewed the agenda items that were discussed as they relate to Hidalgo County and we provide the following progress report.

#### 4. REPORTS:

- A. HCRMA Roadway System Projects – Godfrey Garza, Administrative and Managerial Consultant / Louis Jones, Dannenbaum Engineering Corporation

Godfrey Garza and Louie Jones of Dannenbaum Engineering (GEC) provided a report on the status of the strategic plan for the RMA projects. As per the RMA board all environmental engineering and surveying work with outside consultants has been suspended pending review of the completed plan and direction from the board. Mr. Jones reported that the review of all RMA projects is complete and the draft strategic plan should be available to the board within a week. This would identify projects that would be worked on in the first ten years and if the RMA should continue to include the La Joya Bypass as a priority project.

The current recommendation from the GEC is to move forward with getting a proposal to update the Traffic and Revenue (T&R) studies (approximate 6 month timeframe) to determine what projects have sufficient traffic and should be prioritized. New roadways such as the Anzalduas Highway and the recent violence in Mexico may change existing traffic projections. This fact in conjunction with ongoing coordination with local municipalities to adopt ordinances restricting truck traffic from using local roads would affect traffic projection on RMA toll facilities.

This data would then be applied to the strategic plan and then the decision would be made on what projects would be developed and in what order. Mr. Jones recommended the board allow the GEC to move forward with the Environmental Classification letter portion of the modified TCC (see attached) project and hold off on other work until the T&R study and strategic plan are complete.

In addition the GEC will be preparing cost proposals to complete the remainder of the work on the other RMA projects should the board choose to move forward.

The board moved to acknowledge the report from the GEC.

- B. Update on Project Finance – Richard Ramirez/Troy Madres, First Southwest

Mr. Ramirez stated he agreed with the plan proposed by the GEC.

- C. Update on Pass Through Projects – Jody Ellington, TxDOT

No report.

Mr. Rios stated progress with the contract is ongoing and near completion.

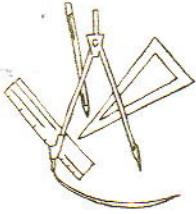


The following tasks were accomplished this month.
