**FUNDING AGREEMENT
FOR BORDER COLONIA ACCESS PROGRAM
AMENDMENT #7**

THIS AMENDMENT IS MADE BY AND BETWEEN the State of Texas, acting through the Texas Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the "State", and Hidalgo County, acting by and through its duly authorized officials, hereinafter called the "County".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the State and the County executed a contract on the 28th day of August 2008 – amended on the 15th day of January 2009, on the 17th day of March 2010, on the 13th day of August 2010, on the 20th day of June 2011, on the 1st day of November 2011 and on the 21st day of March 2012 – to effectuate their agreement to establish a transportation program to construct access roads in the County; and,

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to extend that contract in order to utilize existing funding; and,

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to extend that contract; and,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and agreements of the parties hereto, the State and the Local Government do agree as follows:

A G R E E M E N T

Article 1. Description of Amended Item:

Article 3, Schedule, is voided in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Upon final execution of this Agreement, the County shall submit to the State a project schedule. This schedule shall include a monthly project development timeline including estimated monthly expenditures. If the County does not let the construction contract within five (5) years of the execution of this Agreement or complete the Project within six (6) years of the execution of this Agreement, this Agreement will be terminated in accordance with the provisions of Article 9, Termination.

Article 9.c. is voided in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Project is not let within five (5) years of the original execution of this agreement, or the Project is not completed within six (6) years of the original execution of this agreement.

All other provisions of the original contract are unchanged and remain in full force and effect.

Article 2. Signatory Warranty

The signatories to this amendment warrant that each has the authority to enter into this agreement on behalf of the organization they represent.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, THE STATE AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT have executed duplicate counterparts to effectuate this agreement.
