Updated –Numerous meetings have been held with affected property owners and project stakeholders (i.e. Bell Farms, West Family, City of Penitias, HCDD#1, Irrigation District #16, Hidalgo County Pct #3, etc). This effort has been done in coordination w/ TxDOT to vet alignment alternatives for the centerline of the subject referenced project and discuss possible outfalls.		
TASK #2 – Coordination of Improvements to Other Connecting Roadways Such as Mile 3, Tom Gill Rd., Liberty Blvd., etc.	L&G	25.5hrs Various Personnel
Updated –Extensive work has been done on both the Mile 3 and Tom/Gil-Liberty Blvd Corridors as it relates to their impact on the subject referenced project. This impact is both from a drainage and geometrics aspect. We have identified possible outfall locations along Liberty Ave. that might be able to be utilized for the La Joya Relief Route project.

Updated – We have coordinated with HCDD#1 and obtained an “Overall Drainage Study” done for the “Penitas Drain Project” that is to be incorporated into the drainage system for the subject referenced project. We have met multiple times with Mr.		

<p>Godfrey Garza on the topic of drainage for the subject referenced project and have produced a conceptual "Hydrologic Map" to be presented at the upcoming public meeting. We have coordinated and conducted meetings with Irrigation District #16 to see if out-falling into the "La Joya Lake" is an option. Other proposed outfall alignments are also under evaluation for presentation at the upcoming TxDOT led public meeting.</p>
