

We have reviewed the agenda items that are to be discussed and we would like to advise you that the following item(s) require your attention. We are therefore giving you our recommendations.

TAB III PRESENTATIONS / ACTION / DISCUSSION ITEM(S)

B. Discussion & Approval of HCMPO Planning Contract (**ACTION ITEM**) MPO STAFF

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

Every six years the federal government requires the renewal of the "Planning Contract" between the federal government, the HCMPO, and the fiscal agent to allow the HCMPO to exist. The current fiscal agent to the HCMPO is the Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council (LRGVDC).

The most recent contract is similar to the 2006 contract with minor changes from TxDOT legal. HCMPO staff is proposing the renewal of the planning contract with three (3) amendments. The proposed areas with changes are included in the packet and highlighted in yellow. The document in the packet included the language from the 2006 contract as approved by the Policy Board.

- The first change includes some language that modifies the description of the urbanized area served by the MPO.
- The second amendment is regarding Human Resources (HR) matters as they relate to the Director of the MPO. Currently HR matters including the hiring, termination, and evaluation of the director are executed by the Policy Committee and the proposed changes would transfer the sole responsibility to the LRGVDC director Mr. Ken Jones.
- The third amendment relates to reducing the reimbursement time from 30 days to 15 days as per the recent MAP-21 federal transportation bill.

C. Discussion & Approval of FY2013-16 TIP Amendment #2/ MTP Amendment #9 (ACTION ITEM) MPO STAFF

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

In recent months bids received on TxDOT projects have been 30% to 50% higher than the engineer's estimates for each individual project. On September 11, 2012 the HCMPO requested updates to the construction cost estimates for all the projects on the TIP and MTP. MPO staff, TxDOT, and the Technical Committee are currently reviewing the information received and proposing changes to the planning documents to reflect the updated estimates. The current draft TIP and MTP do not include these updated cost estimates.

In the interim some of the notable changes were made to the TIP:

- Adjustments to the FM 88 project were made to account for the bid received by TxDOT in excess of the originally programmed amount. The overrun was approximately \$1.0 million dollars. The current amendment to the TIP/MTP reflects the additional funding to cover the overrun.
- An additional \$70,000 was programmed to the FM 1926 Operational Improvements project.
- TxDOT let the US 281 project(s) from FM 2812 to FM 490 utilizing TxDOT funding to cover the approx \$5.0 million dollar cost overrun.
- 2 Mile line from SH 107 to Inspiration Road was moved from FY 2013 to FY 2014.
- 2 Mile line from Inspiration Road to SH 364 (La Homa Road) was moved from FY 2013 to FY 2014.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is our recommendation to approve the current TIP and MTP amendments as presented. The next revision will most likely reflect major changes to project costs and placement.

D. Discussion & Approval of "No Truck in Left Lane" Resolution (ACTION ITEM) MPO STAFF

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

In the preceding months the HCMPO has worked with TxDOT to study the benefits of restricting heavy truck traffic in the left lane. The signage would inform drivers that the outermost lane is to be used for "passing only". This restriction would only apply on the US 83 Expressway and portions of US 281 with 3 travel lanes in each direction.

TxDOT is in concurrence with the proposal and pledges to oversee the process and provide the needed coordination and public involvement to implement the necessary changes to laws / ordinances. In addition TxDOT has agreed to cover the costs associated with the necessary signage.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is our recommendation that the MPO approve the resolution of support as presented.

E. Discussion & Approval of CAT 7 Resolution (ACTION ITEM) MPO STAFF

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

In recent months bids received by TxDOT on transportation projects funded by the HCMPO have been in excess of the engineers estimate and over the programmed amount at the MPO. The proposed resolution intends to implement a system to cover cost overruns and allow projects to be let without further formal action from the HCMPO Technical and Policy committees.

Time constraints between TxDOT bid openings and final approval by the TxDOT Transportation Commission do not allow time for review and a meeting of the MPO Technical Committee after bids are received in the same calendar month.

The alternative solution to this resolution is for the HCMPO Policy Committee agenda include an action item to individually approve any overrun at the monthly policy meeting and evaluate its potential effects to other projects on the TIP and MTP without review by the Technical committee.

F. Discussion & Approval of Transportation Enhancement Program Call **(ACTION ITEM)** TxDOT

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

In the preceding months TxDOT and the MPO have been working to identify Transportation Enhancement projects within cities and the county. Two eligible projects were identified within the cities of Edinburg and McAllen.

RECCOMENDATION:

It is our recommendation that the MPO approve the resolution of support for the projects that were submitted.

Dear Judge Garcia:

As your Technical Representative for the Hidalgo County MPO, we provide you with a monthly HCRMA update. Attached for your use and information is the HCRMA Meeting Agenda(s) for the meeting held on Thursday October 18, 2012 at 5:30 P.M. We have reviewed the agenda items that were discussed as they relate to Hidalgo County and have provided the following progress report.

**CALL TO ORDER FOR REGULAR MEETING
PUBLIC COMMENT
1. REPORTS**

A. Update on SH 365 Financing – Jody Ellington, TxDOT

Norma Garza of TxDOT provided an update regarding the SH 365 (West) project. Recently TxDOT provided the HCRMA with a Draft of the Advanced Funding Agreement for the SH 365 project. This agreement outlines the terms for the \$112 million in TxDOT funding that will be allocated to the SH 365 project. These funds were sourced from the previously allocated TxDOT Pass Through funding awarded to HCRMA projects.

TxDOT is currently working on comments on the agreement and hope to have them completed by next week.

B. Update on SH 365 Project – Louis Jones, Program Manager

Mr. Louis Jones of Dannenbaum Engineering provided an update on the status of individual tasks related to the development of HCRMA projects. The critical item mentioned in this update was the status of the Environmental Classification Letter for the SH 365 (TCC) project. Mr. Jones anticipates a decision by TxDOT / FHWA on the environmental classification of the SH 365 project by the end of the 2012 calendar year. The Traffic and Revenue (T&R) study should be completed in the same timeframe.

Mr. Jones also reported that drainage studies associated with the SH 365 (west) project had been turned in and were under review.

C. Update on Overweight Truck Corridor Proposal – Pilar Rodriguez, Executive Director

Mr. Pilar Rodriguez, Executive Director of the HCRMA, provided an update on the status of the overweight truck corridor. Discussions are underway on possibly extending the corridor to the east to connect to the Alliance International Bridge in Donna, Texas.

A. Resolution 2012-33 – Amendment and Restatement of Work Authorization Number 5 of Professional Service Agreement with Dannenbaum Engineering for Public Outreach

This item relates to the public involvement efforts by the HCRMA. This item was discussed in executive session and was approved unanimously.

B. Resolution 2012-24 – Amending 2012-2017 Strategic Plan – Project Manager Strategy No. 8 to include Environmental Clearance and Preliminary Engineering of SH 365 from FM 396 to FM 1016 and related actions

C. Resolution 2012-29 – Approval of Interlocal Agreement with the City of Mission and Mission Redevelopment Authority for Advance Project Development of SH 365 from FM 396 to FM 1016

D. Resolution 2012-30 – Approval of Supplemental No. 1 to Work Authorization No. 1 of Professional Service Agreement with L&G Engineering for Preliminary Engineering of SH 365 from FM 396 to FM 1016

E. Resolution 2012-31 – Approval of Supplemental No. 2 to Consulting Agreement with Atkins North America, Inc. adding Environmental Clearance of SH 365 from FM 396 to FM 1016

Items 3 - B, C, D, and E relate to the extension of the limits of the SH 365 (west) project from FM 396 east to FM 1016. The Mission Redevelopment Authority in conjunction with the City of Mission completed an inter-local agreement with the HCRMA to advance the funds needed to complete the additional environmental and engineering work associated with the extension of the project to the west. The HCRMA approved supplemental agreements to existing work authorizations with consultants currently working on the design and environmental documents related to the adjoining section of the project.

These items were approved unanimously.

F. Resolution 2012-34 – Approval of Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for the SH 365 Project

This item was discussed in executive session; no action was taken in executive session.
