ORDER REGULATING PARKING IN THE PARKING LOT OF THE OLD ADMINISTRATION BUILDING AND PROVIDING FOR TOWING AND STORAGE OF UNAUTHORIZED PARKED VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Hidalgo County, at a duly called and noticed meeting on January 22, 2013, and pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 615.001, voted to regulate vehicle parking in the parking lot of the Old Administration Building located at the intersection of Closner and E. Mahl streets, Edinburg, Texas (the "Parking Lot");

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County is experiencing unauthorized vehicles parked in reserved spaces at the Parking Lot; and

WHEREAS, Section 615.001 of the Texas Local Government Code provides the commissioners court may regulate the parking of vehicles on property owned or leased by the county including the towing and storage of a vehicle at the vehicle owner's expense if the vehicle is parked in violation of rules adopted under section 615.001 of the Texas Local Government Code;

THEREFORE, BE IT NOW ORDERED BY THE HIDALGO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT that parking in the Parking Lot of the Old Administration Building is regulated as follows:

1. Parking Spaces in the Parking Lot marked reserved are limited to vehicles of the office or person(s) to whom the reserved parking space is assigned.
2. Unauthorized vehicles parked in a reserved parking space in the Parking Lot between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday other than a County of Hidalgo holiday shall be towed and stored from the Parking Lot at the vehicle owner's expense.
3. Appropriately worded sign(s) shall be placed at the south entrances to the Parking Lot to inform drivers of vehicles of the prohibition of parking vehicles in reserved spaces and that vehicles parked in reserved spaces will be towed and stored at the vehicles owner's expense.

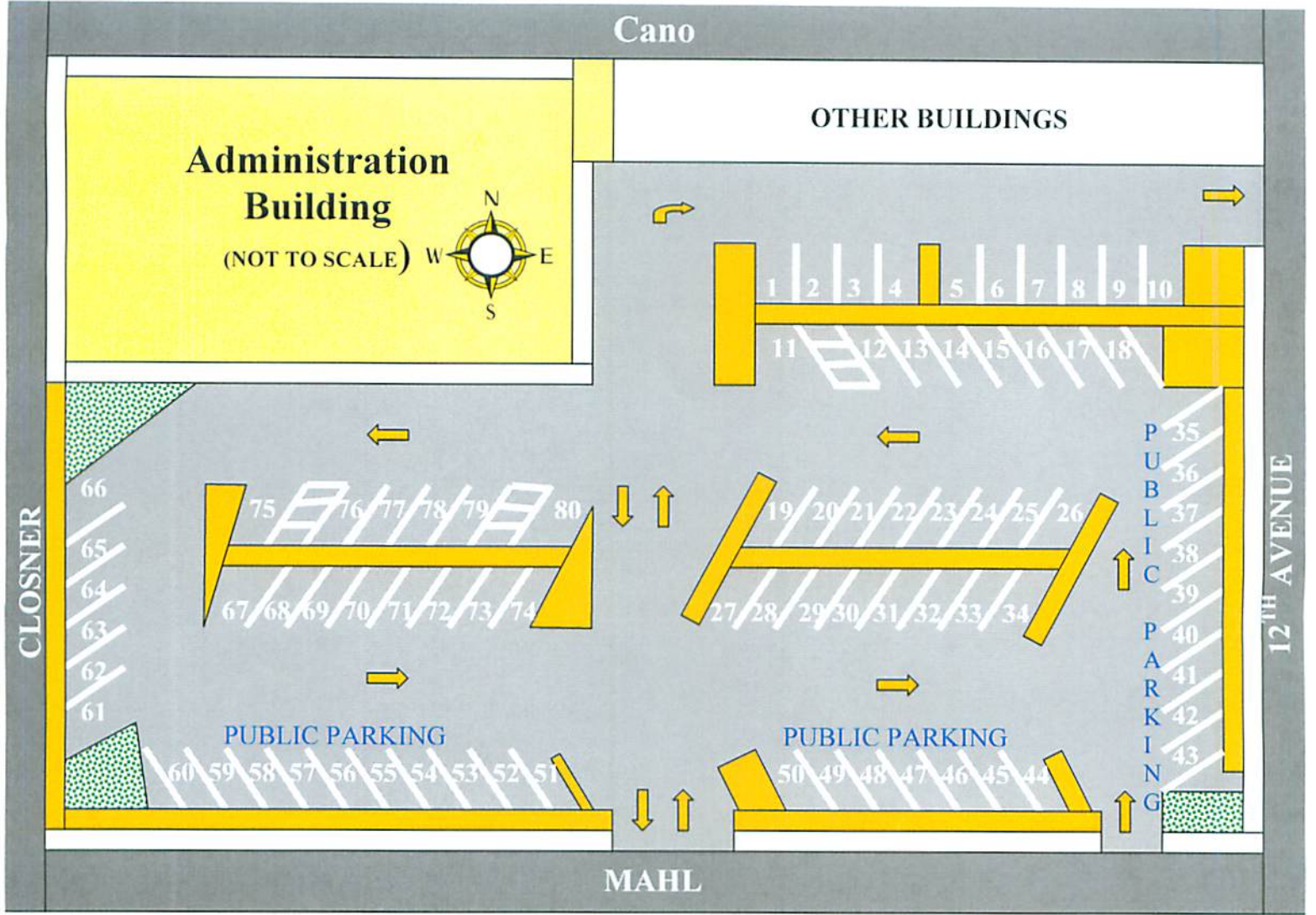
