**INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF HIDALGO
AND HIDALGO COUNTY IRRIGATION DISTRICT NO. 6**

This Agreement is made on this the 22 day of January, 2013, by and between the **HIDALGO COUNTY IRRIGATION DISTRICT NO. 6**, hereinafter referred to as "District" and **COUNTY OF HIDALGO**, hereinafter referred to as "County" pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Interlocal Cooperation Act, as follows:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, District is a irrigation district governed by Chapter 49 of the Texas Water Code located in County, Mission, Texas; and

WHEREAS, County is a county in the State of Texas;

WHEREAS, County desires to seek assistance from the District for the installation of irrigation crossings on Mile 2 from La Homa Road to Abram Road ("the Road") with Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Precinct No.3 Year 24 (2011) Street Improvement funds;

WHEREAS, County agrees it is in the its best interest to purchase such services as needed;

WHEREAS, County and District are authorized to enter into this Agreement pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Gov't Code 791.001 et seq., which authorizes local governments to contract with each other to perform governmental functions and services under the terms of the Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, County and District, in consideration of the mutual covenants expressed hereinafter, agree as follows:

1. District agrees to replace all irrigation lines located in County's right of way damaged or destroyed by County in County's new construction in widening and paving the Road.
2. County agrees to reimburse District against paid receipt the cost of supplies, materials and labor at District's cost incurred for the replacement of the irrigation lines located within the Road right of way damaged or destroyed by County. County shall reimburse District in thirty (30) days following the completion of District's work described herein and District's delivery to County the paid receipt(s) for supplies, materials and labor.
3. District and county shall coordinate work schedules in order to provide for minimal disruption of traffic and operation of the Streets.
4. Each party agrees to conform to its own applicable purchasing laws, regulations, policies, and procedures with respect to the portion of the work under this Agreement performed by each party.

5. **Conflict with Applicable Law.** Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed so as to require the commission of any act contrary to law, and whenever there is a conflict between any provision of this Agreement and any present or future law, ordinance or administrative, executive or judicial regulation, order or decree, or amendment thereof, contrary to which the parties have no legal right to contract, the latter shall prevail, but in such event necessary to bring them within the legal requirements and during the times such conflict exists.
6. **No Waiver.** No waiver by any party hereto of any breach of any provision of this Agreement shall be deemed to be a waiver of any preceding or succeeding, breach of the same or any other provision thereof.
7. **Entire Agreement.** This Agreement contains the entire contract among the parties hereto, and each party acknowledges that no other party has made (either directly or through any agent or representative) any representations or agreements in connection with this Agreement not specifically set forth herein. This Agreement may be modified or amended only by agreement in writing executed by Edcouch and County, and not otherwise.
8. **TEXAS LAW TO APPLY.** THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE CONSTRUED UNDER AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, AND ALL OBLIGATION OF THE PARTIES CREATED HEREUNDER ARE PERFORMABLE IN HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS. THE PARTIES HEREBY CONSENT TO PERSONAL JURISDICTION IN HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS.
9. **Notice.** Except as may be otherwise specifically provided in this Agreement, all notices, demands, requests or communication required or permitted hereunder shall be in writing and shall either be (i) personally delivered against a written receipt, or addressed to the parties at the addressed set forth below, or (ii) at such other address as may have been theretofore specified by written notice delivered in accordance herewith:

Each notice, demand, request or communication which shall be delivered or mailed in the manner described above shall be deemed sufficiently given for all purposes at such time

as it is personally delivered to the addressee or, if mailed, at such time as it is deposited in the United States mail.

10. **Additional Documents.** The Parties hereto covenant and agree that they will execute such other and future instruments and documents as are or may become necessary or convenient to effectuate and carry out the terms of this Agreement.
11. **Successors.** This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors, and assigns where permitted by this Agreement.
12. **Assignment.** This Agreement shall not be assignable.
13. **Headings.** The headings and captions contained in this Agreement are solely for convenient reference and shall not be deemed to affect the meaning or interpretation of any provision or paragraph hereof.
14. **Gender and Number.** All pronouns used in this Agreement shall include the other gender, whether used in the masculine, feminine or neuter gender, and the singular shall include the plural whenever and as often as may be appropriate.
15. **Authority to Execute.** The execution and performance of this Agreement by each of the parties hereto have been duly authorized by all necessary laws, resolutions, ordinances, or governing body action, and this Agreement constitutes the valid and enforceable obligations of the parties hereto in accordance with its terms
16. **Governmental Purpose.** Each party hereto is entering into this Agreement for the purpose of providing for government services or functions, and will pay for such services out of revenues as identified in this Agreement.
17. **Entire Agreement.** This Agreement contains the entire contract between the parties hereto, and each party acknowledges that neither has made (either directly or through any agent or representative) any representation or agreement in connection with this Agreement not specifically set forth herein. This Agreement may be modified or amended only by agreement in writing executed by the parties hereto, and not otherwise.
18. **Commitment of Current Revenues Only.** In the event that, during any term hereof the governing body of any party does not appropriate sufficient funds to meet the obligations of such party under this Agreement, that any party may terminate this Agreement upon ninety (90) days written notice to the other party. Each of the parties hereto agrees, however, to use its best efforts to secure funds necessary for the continued performance of this Agreement. The parties intend this provision to be a continuing right to terminate this Agreement at the expiration of each budget period of each party hereto pursuant to the provision of Tex. Loc. Govt. Code Ann. §271.903.

Mile 2 North Road (La Homa Road to FM 492)**


Dear Mr. Aguilar,

As you are aware, Hidalgo County Precinct No. 3 is proposing to pave Mile 2 North Road from La Homa Road to FM 492. This roadway is located adjacent and south of a HCID No. 6 Canal. This roadway is currently a caliche type roadway and has created numerous problems to the residents of the area complaining of dust control and overall safety of the roadway. Hidalgo County Precinct No. 3 is requesting approval of this construction from the HCID No. 6 Board of Directors for this construction as part of the roadway will be located within District 6 right of way. A total of 118,247 (2.71 Acres) square feet of property will be utilized for this construction for the entire length of the project. In addition a total of 21 irrigation crossings will be replaced at a cost of \$46,305.00 as part of the project and will be constructed with a minimum of 4 feet of cover. All costs associated with construction of this roadway including any utility adjustments or relocations shall be the responsibility of Hidalgo County Precinct No. 3.
