

### **TAB III PRESENTATIONS / ACTION / DISCUSSION ITEM(S)**

#### **B. Discussion & Approval of Release of Spring 2013 CMP RFP (ACTION ITEM) MPO STAFF**

##### **TECHNICAL INFORMATION:**

The MPO is preparing to release the Request for Proposal for the bi-annual Congestion Management Plan (CMP). This study has been a useful tool in identifying congested roadways and intersections. This data has provided the MPO the ability to appropriate Operational Improvements funds more efficiently. Additionally, past CMP data allows the MPO to identify improvements in traffic flow as a result of a completed roadway project.

##### **RECCOMENDATION:**

It is our recommendation that the board approve the item as presented.

#### **C. Discussion & Approval of FY2012 APER (ACTION ITEM) MPO STAFF**

##### **TECHNICAL INFORMATION:**

The above item references the HCMPO Annual Performance and Expenditure Report (APER). This annual report is provided to TxDOT and FHWA that summarizes the expenditures of the HCMPO over the previous fiscal year

##### **RECCOMENDATION:**

It is our recommendation to approve the APER as presented.

D. Discussion & Approval of Resolution of Co-Designation of US 83 & US 77 **(ACTION ITEM) MPO STAFF**

**TECHNICAL INFORMATION:**

In the preceding months TxDOT and many entities in the South Texas have worked towards receiving an interstate designation on US 281, US 77, and US 83. This item relates to resolutions in support of these designations occurring in the coming months. The resolutions are attached.

**RECCOMENDATION:**

It is our recommendation that these resolutions of support be approved as presented.

TxDOT has also asked that the TPC consider approval of two (2) Resolutions supporting the designation of US77 and US281 as part of the Interstate 69 system as well as a Resolution supporting US83 being co-designated as part of the Interstate system as a connector to US77 and US281. These Resolutions were unanimously approved by TAC for consideration and adoption by TPC.

E. Discussion of 2013-2016 TIP Amendment #3 & 2010-2035 MTP Amendment #10 **(DISCUSSION ITEM) MPO STAFF**

**TECHNICAL INFORMATION:**

In the preceding 6-8 months bids received on TxDOT projects have been 30% to 50% higher than the engineer's estimates for each individual project. This prompted the HCMPO and TxDOT to request updates to the construction cost estimates for all the projects on the TIP and MTP. These revised costs were incorporated into the projects on the MTP and created a \$42 million dollar negative balance in the MTP.

The federal government requires the TIP and MTP to be "balanced or "fiscally constrained" by the end of the calendar year. Every effort was made to not disturb projects that are in development (engineering/environmental/ROW) or have Advanced Funding Agreements in place with TxDOT. This resulted in the following changes being made to the TIP/MTP:

- Owassa, HC-106, moved from 2014 to 2018
- La Homa, HC-48b, moved from 2014 to 2015
- La Joya, Relief Route, HC-60c, moved from 2015 to 2022
- 10th street, HC-79, moved from 2016 to 2017
- FM 676, HC-117b, moved from 2019 to 2023
- FM 907, HC-119, moved from 2020 to 2023
- Dicker Rd. was placed in 2023.
- SH 336, HC-249a, moved from 2014 to 2015
- Liberty Road, HC-284a, moved from 2017 to 2020

TxDOT has committed to working with local entities to let projects as they become ready. This means that if a project listed in later years of the MTP and becomes "shovel ready" and has environmental clearance and ROW in place it will be let ahead of schedule. As you can see, the Technical Committee and staff have had to make very challenging decisions with regards to projects and funding availability. The current DRAFT MTP dated December 3, 2012 is attached for your use.

**REMINDER:** This presentation of the MTP is for discussion only and will be formally voted on at the January 2013 Policy meeting.

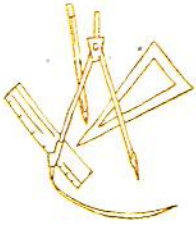

Dear Commissioner Palacios:

As your Technical Representative for the Hidalgo County MPO, we provide you with a monthly HCRMA update. Attached for your use and information is the HCRMA Meeting Agenda(s) for the meeting held on Tuesday December 18, 2012 at 5:30 P.M. We have reviewed the agenda items that were discussed as they relate to Hidalgo County and have provided the following progress report.

**CALL TO ORDER FOR WORKSHOP**

**1. Review of Traffic & Revenue Study and Finance Plan for SH 365 and IBTC Projects**

Representatives from C&M, the Traffic and Revenue consultant, provided a presentation regarding the latest traffic projections for projects being developed by the RMA. The most recent Traffic and Revenue (T&R) study completed in December 2012 has shown a significant drop, approximately 60%, in projected traffic from the study completed by the RMA in 2010.

The traffic consultant attributed the majority of this drop to the following factors:

- No truck restrictions on the existing roadway network.
  - The 2010 study included the expectation that local municipalities would restrict trucks from utilizing existing roadways after the construction of the toll way.
- The large drop in passenger car border crossings since 2009
- The construction of the Anzalduas Highway
- The violence in Mexico

According to C&M no single factor was entirely responsible for the decline in traffic projections; the cumulative effect was larger than the sum of the individual factors.

## 1. REPORTS

### A. Update on SH 365 Project – Louis Jones, Program Manager

Mr. Louie Jones of Dannenbaum Engineering, the Program Manager (PM), provided an update on the status of HCRMA projects to the board. Currently the Environmental classification letter for the SH 365 project is being reviewed by TxDOT ENV in Austin. The HCRMA anticipates concurrence with the EA determination by FHWA in mid-January.

Mr. Jones and the HCRMA's financial advisor, First Southwest, also reported that despite the large drop in traffic projections provided by C&M the HCRMA has several viable scenarios to continue the development of the SH 365 and IBTC projects to shovel ready status and fund SH 365 through construction in the near future.

## 3. REGULAR AGENDA

The HCRMA Executive Director, Mr. Pilar Rodriguez, presented the draft 2013 HCRMA budget for adoption. This budget includes funding for a part time Chief Financial Officer and project management software as well as current HCRMA expenses.

This item was approved unanimously.
