

Good afternoon Matyi!

I know Precinct 1 had verbally indicated to me that they were interested in taking over the copier left by Precinct 5, but I do understand that the County needs to know all of their options. Below are the following options that Hidalgo County has for the Ricoh MPC2051 that was left over by Precinct 5.

- 1) Ricoh will move the machine to a different department (at no cost) and the new department would simply take over payments for the remainder of the lease. (Monthly Payment of \$127.50/month for the next 30 months & overages for b/w copies @\$0.009 and color usage @ \$0.072 billed quarterly - Contract expires 5/18/15)
- 2) Hidalgo County can choose to request a Buyout To Return quote from the Ricoh Financial Team. Hidalgo County can payoff the amount remaining on the machine's lease and then return the machine to Ricoh.
- 3) Hidalgo County can elect to exercise their Non-Appropriation of Funds right. This option would affect Hidalgo County's future leasing options with industry vendors.
