- Pre-existing conditions are **not covered** for twelve months from effective date.
- Accidents are paid for 12 **consecutive** months from the date of accident. You must be disabled by a licensed physician within 30 days of your accident.
- Each Disability plan includes a \$25,000 accidental death benefit.
