

RESOLUTION

A Resolution of Commissioner's Court of the County of Hidalgo, Texas, regarding the funding from the Texas General Land Office Disaster Recovery Program and local funds to be committed by Hidalgo County Precinct No. 4.

WHEREAS, the County of Hidalgo Precinct No. 4 desires to participate in the State of Texas Plan for Disaster Recovery Round 2.2, as funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and commit a local contribution of \$727,185.60 from its Rural Development Funds Account.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the community to combine funding committed by Hidalgo County Precinct No. 4 (\$727,185.60) and the Texas General Land Office (\$1,700,000.00) for the completion of the project known as the Alberta Drain Project. The total funding for the drainage improvements is \$2,427,185.60; and

WHEREAS, the County of Hidalgo, in conjunction with the state awarded funding provided by the Texas General Land Office will allow the County to make drainage improvements to phase I Alberta Drain Project located between Owassa Road and Alberta Road starting at an existing ditch located approximately one mile east of Tower Road and then running west to approximately 1,320 feet west of Tower Road

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF THE COUNTY OF HIDALGO, TEXAS:

That Hidalgo County's Precinct No. 4 has committed funding in the amount of \$727,185.60 with intent to address regional drainage improvements for the above referenced geographic area.
