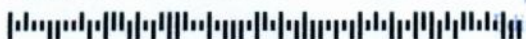

Verizon Service Performance Guarantee

When you place an order or request repair service, we'll give you a date when we'll complete the installation or local service repair work. If we don't meet that commitment, call us and request a credit of \$25 for residence customers or \$100 for business customers. Although we're offering this guarantee, our goal is to give you no reason to use it. We have a long-standing commitment to providing quality service and meeting the needs of our customers. Questions? Municipal Right-of-Way Fee

Beginning July 1, 2013, you may see an increase in the amount you pay for municipal right-of-way fees. This fee is collected by Verizon to recover the payments made to your city for the use of the right-of-way to provide services.

Verizon Surcharges

Verizon's Surcharges include:

- (i) a Federal Subscriber Line and/or Access Recovery Charge that helps pay for the costs of providing and maintaining the local phone network;
 - (ii) a Federal Universal Service Charge applicable to interstate and international services to recover fees imposed on us by the government to support universal service;
 - (iii) a Long Distance Access Charge to help defray the cost of access charges and fees that local exchange companies assess on us or our agents for state to state and international calling;
 - (iv) a Carrier Cost Recovery Charge applicable to long distance customers that helps defray the costs we pay to support interstate Telecommunication Relay Service, government number administration, local number portability, and other fees assessed by the FCC; and
 - (v) a Long Distance Administrative Charge applicable to long distance customers to help defray account servicing costs for state to state and international calling.

Important Verizon Freedom for Business Information

Effective September 21, 2013, there will be a \$4.00 monthly increase to the Month-to-Month and Term rates for the following Verizon Freedom for Business plans:

- * Verizon Freedom Basic for Business, Local with Toll
- * Verizon Freedom Basic for Business, Local

The new rates will be reflected in bills dated on or after September 21, 2013. If you are currently on an existing Verizon Freedom for Business Term plan, you will not be subject to this increase until the current term expires. Once the term expires, the plan will be automatically renewed with the \$4.00 price increase. If you do not want the plan to automatically renew, you must call the business office to remove or change your plan. FUSF Surcharge Changes July 2, 2013

Your Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF) surcharge may change on July 2, 2013. Authorized and reviewed quarterly by the FCC, the FUSF funds programs to keep local telephone rates affordable for all customers and provides discounts to schools, libraries, rural health care providers, and low-income families.
