Dear Honorable Judge Garcia:

In compliance with the implementation of the County Assistance Program as defined under the rules of TAC Title 43, Part 1, Chapter 29, Subchapter A, Rule § 29.3 (43TAC § 29.3), the Local Assistance Program Section 201.706, Transportation Code, and Rider 19, HB 1, revised and passed during the last Legislative Session.

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is required to assist counties with materials to repair and maintain county roads. The amount appropriated to each county is primarily based on the county's percentage of statewide 2060 weight tolerance permits, county road mileage, statewide lane miles of county roads, among other criteria.

For Fiscal Year 2014, Hidalgo County is eligible to receive salvaged material valued up to \$67,613.00. Please submit a written request to collect your annual allotment of salvaged materials. Material request need to specify the material type, quantity and roadway to be used. All requests from Hidalgo County must be approved and signed by you.
