Renan/Phillip,

I have reviewed the Amendment No. 5 to the Techshare Resource Sharing Addendum CIJS agreement

which includes revisions to the following: 1) Attachment "A" – Financial Plan; 2) Amendment to the Amended and Restated Implementation Plan Phase 1 and Phase 2; End User License Agreement and Professional Services Agreement with Exhibit "A" – Software License and Professional Services Agreement and Exhibit "B" – Maintenance and Support Services Agreement. Some of the concerns or changes from the previous form of agreement are noted below:

Software License and Professional Service Agreement:

at Paragraph 4.1 – license fees are to be paid 100% at contract execution (previously had been 50%/50%)

at Paragraph 4.3 – Expenses (previously had language about following our travel policy which Auditor typically requires)

Otherwise, the form of agreement is in order.
