Dear Ms. Salazar

On behalf of RGV Educational Broadcasting, Inc. I would like to advise that due to a possible sale of the station KMBH would like to provide an assessment and options that would allow KMBH to continue to air the delay broadcasting of the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court Meetings.

When and should the sale become final KMBH will transition from a non-commercial to a commercial station, during this transition there is a possibility that KMBH may go off the air for approximately 7-14 days. In addition, KMBH will begin to transmit Valley wide as a Spanish language network on each of its channels. We believe this timeframe will occur in either March or April of 2014.

If possible, based on approval of the above information, KMBH would like to offer to continue airing the Delay Broadcasting of the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court Meetings by signing the one-year extension. An additional option to consider is the possibility of KMBH signing a month-to-month extension. Should a month-to-month extension be considered, KMBH can provide a minimum 30 days notice as to when a cease in delay broadcasting would occur.
