Both Change Orders were initiated by the Purchasing Department. The light poles are not connected to the building. The conduits and wiring are, out of necessity, connected to the building. This is the only electrical power available for the parking lot lights. I believe that the County decided to have these installations done by Holchemont not only to expedite the installations but also to keep this electrical work under one electrical warranty, rather than have a separate electrical contractor. The transformer is an integral part of the system required for the parking lot lights. This item also, out of necessity, has to be wired to an electrical panel at the building. This type of equipment is similar to the emergency generator that was installed for the building. It is not part of the building but it is an accessory necessary for the functioning of the building for its intended use.
