

# RESOLUTION 2014-04

## SUBJECT: Approval of the Hidalgo County Metropolitan Planning Organization Thoroughfare Plan Amendment

WHEREAS, the Hidalgo County Metropolitan Planning Organization, is the designated agency for the Transportation Planning in the Transportation Management Area; and

WHEREAS, the MPO is required to have a systematic way to gather citizen input on transportation issues; and


WHEREAS, the MPO is required to have a financially constrained 4 year project listing (TIP); and


WHEREAS, these procedures have been duly discussed and gone through the required public comment period; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hidalgo County Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Policy Committee agreed by a majority vote to approve the following amendments to the HCMPO Thoroughfare Plan.

- From County Commissioner Precinct #1:
  - Downgrade from a 120' to 100' on Mile 2 West road between Mile 8 North and Mile 9 North and between Mile 16 ½ North (SH 107) and Mile 17 ½ North.
  - Removal of Norene Road between FM 1925 (Monte Cristo) and Mile 20 North
- From County Commissioner Precinct #3 to:
  - Add Los Ebanos from Military Parkway heading North for approximately 0.85 miles as an 80'
- From The City of San Juan:
  - Add Retama Street from Owassa Road to FM 495 as 80' ROW
  - Add Retama Street from FM 495 to US Expressway 83 as an 80' ROW
  - Add Oblate Avenue from Minnesota Road to US Expressway as an 80' ROW
  - Add 1<sup>st</sup> Street from Veterans Road to Oblate Street as an 80' ROW
- From The City of Mission:
  - Add 1 Mile South from Schuerbach road to Abram Road as a 100' ROW.
  - Add Glasscock Road from FM 1016 (Military Road) to FM 494 as an 80' ROW
  - Add Los Ebanos from Expressway 281 heading south for approximately 1.26 miles as an 80' ROW
