ORDER

On this day came to be heard the State of Texas, by and through the Hidalgo County District Attorney Application for Impoundment of Election Material and the Court is of the opinion that said application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all election materials, records and equipment pertaining to the February 18-28, 2014, and March 4, 2014, Democratic Primary Election in Hidalgo County, Texas, be impounded immediately and placed for safekeeping under the direction of Yvonne Ramon, the Hidalgo County Elections Administrator.

All elections records, materials and equipment, including the following items are to be impounded:

1. All Democratic voting terminals from all **early voting polling** sites/locations, including mobile units.
2. All Democratic voting terminals from all **election day voting polling** sites/locations.
3. Bags containing all Democratic PEBs (personal electronic ballots), to include the master PEB and activator PEB, CF's (compact flashcards), to include master CF's, and keys.
4. A list identifying the serial number for each Democratic CF and the terminal to which it was assigned and the respective polling site/location for each terminal.
5. The stand alone computers as follows: a.) The computer identified with Hidalgo County Asset Identification Number 44309, and b.) The computer identified with Hidalgo County Asset Identification Number 44307; said computers code elections and enter election results.

6. All Democratic Tapes containing voting data (to include 0 tapes).
7. All Democratic Unused ballots.
8. The PEB reader and any other terminal or auxiliary equipment used in conjunction with said Democratic election.
9. All documents and records related to the coding, counting, verification, logic and accuracy of Democratic electronic voting machines and equipment used in said election, (commonly known as logic and accuracy records).
10. All Democratic Ballot boxes with locks and keys.
11. All Democratic Combination Forms for early vote and election date vote.
12. All Containers with the Democratic envelopes, Democratic provisional ballots, Democratic mail ballots and envelopes and all contents therein.
13. All Democratic Applications for mail ballots and list of persons requesting mail ballots.
14. All Democratic Opened Yellow Carrier Envelopes.
15. All Democratic Cancelled Ballot by Mail Forms.
16. All documents and records related to Democratic Assistant Oaths.
17. Documents and records of Democratic elections judges, assistants, and registered poll watchers.
