RE: Targeted Employment Area Designation

Dear Mr. Healy:

On October 24, 2011, Texas Governor Rick Perry delegated his authority to certify that a particular geographic or political subdivision meets the unemployment rate criteria to qualify as a Targeted Employment Area (as such term is defined at 8 CFR §204.6(e), "TEA") to, among others, county judges in the State of Texas, as the appropriate governmental body(ies) of the state to carry out such certifications. Specifically, Governor Perry's letter provided as follows:

"County judges of each affected county may jointly designate areas of high unemployment in the event that a particular area of high unemployment is located within the boundaries of two or more contiguous counties."

Pursuant to that authority, we hereby certify the geographic area comprised of the below-listed grouping of contiguous census tracts in Webb County, Zapata County, Starr County and Hidalgo County, Texas, as a single Targeted Employment Area for the Civitas Laredo Regional Center ("CLRC"):
