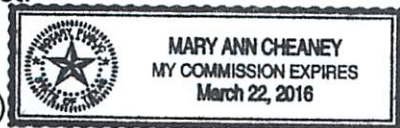

ACT 2008 (ACT 802)

Section 10(1)

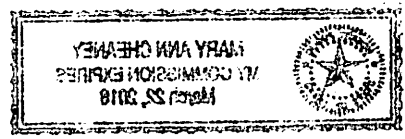
10(1) A person who is a member of the Commission shall, in the exercise of his or her functions, be subject to the following provisions of this Act, namely—

- (a) he or she shall not be liable for any civil or criminal proceedings in respect of any act done in good faith in the exercise of his or her functions;
- (b) he or she shall not be liable for any civil or criminal proceedings in respect of any act done in the exercise of his or her functions if he or she can prove that he or she acted reasonably and honestly;
- (c) he or she shall not be liable for any civil or criminal proceedings in respect of any act done in the exercise of his or her functions if he or she can prove that he or she acted in accordance with the instructions of the Commission;
- (d) he or she shall not be liable for any civil or criminal proceedings in respect of any act done in the exercise of his or her functions if he or she can prove that he or she acted in accordance with the instructions of the Commission and that he or she acted reasonably and honestly;
