





The 2012 Operation Stonegarden performance grant period will end August 15, 2014. Total funding awarded to Hidalgo County under Operation Stonegarden 2012 was \$3,115,631.78. These funds were shared with sixteen (16) local law enforcement agencies and Texas Department of Public Safety (TXDPS), Texas Parks and Wildlife Division (TPWD) and Office of the Attorney General (OAG) which were invited to participate in 2012 Operation Stonegarden.


