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NARRATIVE:

On January 18, 2002 at about 4:54 p.m. I Deputy Itziana Peña was dispatched west of Valverde on Canton road the first brick residence after the canal on the north side in regards to an open door which turned out to be a burglary of habitation report.

Victim Maricela Mena said that,

- She is an employee of the Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office.
- Today at about 7:45 a.m., she left her residence and went to work.
- She came back at about 4:41 p.m. and noticed the front door to residence was wide open.
- She checked the residence and found no one inside.
- She noticed the dead bolt of the front burglar bar door had been removed.
- She noticed the front door had been kicked in to gain entry.
- She noticed that one B-B gun rifle was missing from the living room area.
- She noticed that her service weapon



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NARRATIVE:

a Sig Sauer P220 Serial # G148928 was missing from the bedroom area.

- She did not give consent to anyone to enter or take items from her residence.
- She wishes to file charges against the person(s) found responsible for this matter.

Deputy Actions / Observations I,

- Noticed Mrs. Mena was very upset.
- Noticed the burglary bar door, the front door, and the frame, were damaged.
- Dusted for latent fingerprints and was able to lift some partial prints from different locations of the residence.
- Took several photographs of the scene.
- Noticed Investigator Gabriel Rizzo arrived at my location and made contact with several of the neighbors in the area.
- Provided a case number to Mrs. Mena and advised her to contact the Sheriff's Office for further assistance.
- Checked the area for possible suspects or missing items, but to no avail.



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NARRATIVE:

- Advised dispatched to enter the weapon as a stolen weapon into the TCIC/NIC system.
- Advised the next shift of the incident and to provide extra patrol.
- Submitted the latent fingerprint in the Ervay bin at the Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office.
