Narrative

Investigation:

On November 26, 2013, I Investigator Orlando Montalvo #4571 was at my residence 1105 Dormendo Street Edinburg, Texas 78539. When I noticed my Hidalgo County Sheriff Office issued Assault Rifle missing from the back seat of my Hidalgo County Sheriff CID unit.

I checked my unit and did not observe any type of pry marks on my unit doors. I checked on the tool box on the bed of the truck and did not locate the Assault Rifle. I checked the interior of the unit again and noticed a personal owned gun cleaning kit was also missing from the back seat of my unit. I did not notice any other items missing from the unit. The other items I had in my unit were a Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office tactical vest, a duty bag that had two fully loaded 223 cal. clips on the side pocket, two ammo boxes of 223 cal.

The week prior to my assault rifle missing I was in training at the S.O Academy for the week for the mandated 40hrs training. While in training my cell phone was taken from the desk where I was sitting at and my cell phone was later recovered inside the instructor's podium and this occurred on Tuesday November 19, 2013.

On Thursday November 21, 2013 my unit keys were taken from the desk I was sitting at. On the same day after class the keys were located inside the fire extinguisher box located by the door in class room 2 by Instructor Carlos Olivarez.

On Friday, November 22, 2013 next day after the key incident I asked Instructor P. Hinojosa if I could place my keys inside his desk at which time he told me that was fine. I placed my unit keys inside the top left hand drawer of Instructor Hinojosa desk. After the class was over I asked Instructor Hinojosa if I could take my keys from his desk. Instructor Hinojosa advised me that I could and I took my keys from Instructor Hinojosa desk and left the Sheriff's Office. I went home and parked my unit in front of my residence on the road way. That evening I left to a High School football game at the Cats Stadium in Edinburg, Texas with my family and returned back at around 7:30 PM due to the weather.

For the rest of the weekend my unit stayed parked at my residence. I did go out on some family functions during the weekend but was home most of the time. On Monday at about 9:30PM I used my unit to sign paperwork at the office and came back to the house and parked the unit on the side of the road in front of the house facing westbound. I did not check to see if my assigned assault rifle was in the back seat at that time.

The last time I saw the assault rifle was seen in my unit was Thursday November 21, 2013 in the morning at around 7:30AM. On November 26, 2013 at about 3:40PM, I noticed the assault rifle missing from my unit while at my residence. When I exit off my unit at any time, I double check my unit to make sure it locks properly. On Monday night I had left my wallet inside my unit on the passenger side front seat and when I opened my unit this afternoon Tuesday November 26, 2013 it was still in the same place where I left it and noting was taken. I do not believe that my assault rifle was taken Monday, November 25, 2013 during the night due to my wallet still inside my unit the next day.

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On Tuesday March 4, 2014, a one page written lab report was received from the Texas Department of Public Safety crime laboratory, in Austin, Texas. The written lab report was dated, March 4, 2014, and titled, Latent AFIS Laboratory Report. The written lab report listed this agency case number, 13-47309, and issued lab number, HDQ-1312-14198. The written lab report also listed the victim, Orlando Montalvo, and State of Texas.

The submitted evidence was two crime scene latent fingerprint cards. The requested analysis was an AFIS search.

The results of analysis and interpretation were; Two latent prints on card labeled "1" and marked "front left side door (exterior)" have been identified as the left index fingerprint and the second joint of the left middle fingerprint on the exemplars from DPS files SID # 10287408 bearing the name Orlando Leonardo Montalvo. One latent print on card labeled "2" and marked "inside of rear right door" has been identified a the left thumbprint on the exemplars from DPS files for SID # 10287408 bearing the name Orlando Leonardo Montalvo. There are no remaining suitable latent prints.

The written lab report was prepared and approved by Estela Navejas, Latent Print Technician, Texas DPS Austin Crime Laboratory. A copy of the written lab report will be forwarded to case investigator Glen Mendoza.
