Hi All:

The OLS data is ready! Attached is the final OLS 2014 data for your medical point of dispensing (MPOD) sites along with overall data across all 5 MPODs.

The data that was submitted by your EOC has undergone a quality assurance review. Different sources for the same data were compared for accuracy, and we communicated with your EOC's data collector to resolve missing data, inaccurate data and other discrepancies encountered during Operation Lone Star. We then used the most accurate and reliable data known to us and your EOC data collector to calculate your final data.

Here's a brief summary of the services provided at each of your MPODs during OLS 2014:

#### Palmview MPOD

- 2,948 individuals received 11,338 services at this MPOD site.
- 1,221 individuals were seen by a physician and received a medical examination. Of these individuals, 747 (61%) were adults and 434 were children. The value of the medical exams these individuals received amounted to \$215,935.
- 1,322 vaccines were administered to 635 individuals at this site this year. Individual patients received about 2 vaccines each on average (2.08 is the exact average). Had these 1,322 patients received vaccines through the private sector, they would have paid approximately \$122,041.39 for this service.
- Obesity, hypertension, and diabetes mellitus were the most diagnosed conditions in adults at this site. In children the most diagnosed conditions were obesity and vision problems.

#### PSJA MPOD

- 1,883 individuals received 9,185 services at this MPOD site.
- 1,406 individuals were seen by a physician and received a medical examination. Of these individuals, 639 (46%) were adults and 622 (44%) were children (10% couldn't be categorized as

adults or children due to missing information). The value of the medical exams these individuals received amounted to \$244,880.

- 1,790 vaccines were administered to 795 individuals at this site this year. Individual patients received about 2 vaccines each on average (2.25 is the exact average ). Had these 1,790 patients received vaccines through the private sector, they would have paid approximately \$156,963.59 for this service.
- Hypertension, diabetes mellitus, and headache were the most diagnosed conditions in adults at this site during OLS 2014. In children the most diagnosed conditions were hypertension and vision problems.
