Such action of the Weslaco City Commission will be recorded in Volume 49 of the Weslaco Minute Book.

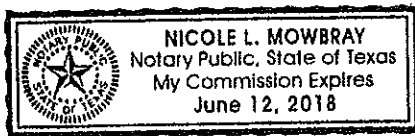



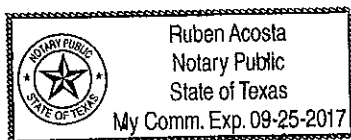
