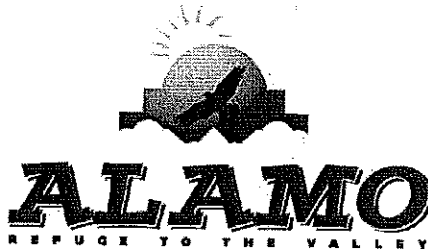


Dear Ms. Leal:





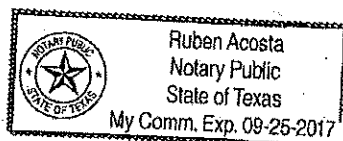
