Hi Paul,

Thanks for your note. In that the state of Texas has no jurisdiction over 501(c)(3)s in regard to purchasing, it would be up to WSCA as to whether it would permit the company to participate in the wireless contract. Municipalities and other entities such as water districts, school districts and assistance organizations such as the Red Cross may use state contracts, TXMAS (some GSA Schedule) contracts and piggyback contracts. **We have also given municipalities permission to use NASPO related contracts.** An example of this is El Paso using the wireless contract. Hope this helps.
