CHAPTER 263. SALE OR LEASE OF PROPERTY BY COUNTIES

SUBCHAPTER D. DISPOSITION OF SALVAGE OR SURPLUS PROPERTY

Sec. 263.151. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:

(1) "Salvage property" means personal property, other than items routinely discarded as waste, that because of use, time, accident, or any other cause is so worn, damaged, or obsolete that it has no value for the purpose for which it was originally intended.

(2) "Surplus property" means personal property that:

(A) is not salvage property or items routinely discarded as waste;

(B) is not currently needed by its owner;

(C) is not required for the owner's foreseeable needs; and

(D) possesses some usefulness for the purpose for which it was intended.

Approval to declare as "surplus" (for the purpose of destruction) staff uniforms from Constable Precinct #3 inasmuch as uniforms cannot be re-cycled (with approval for disposition through the County Sheriff's Department scheduled in March 2011 and subject to weather conditions).

Request ratification for the destruction of Uniform for Constable Precinct #3. Uniforms were salvaged for destruction due to the uniforms being unusable and to ensure that the uniforms would not be used by individuals other than Deputy Constables.

Requesting approval for the destruction of the salvaged departmental uniforms in the interest of safety and security against possible misuse of said items(as they contain county logo) with Purchasing Department witnessing said documenting same. Declare "salvage" (TxLGC 262.151) uniforms described in attachment:
