
Good day. This letter is to respond to the pending CHANGE ORDER requests that are currently awaiting final approval for this project. As we have discussed, these changes are being made to the original contract due to the one-of-a-kind nature of the elements in question. In general, I am in agreement with the proposed changes and believe that they should be approved without delay.

It is my understanding that the following change order items are in question:

- Change order for freezer and cooler door replacement in the kitchen area. My understanding is that the overall scope of work to replace and repair each door to function as originally intended turned out to be somewhat pricier than the original allowance that was allocated. This is simply the nature of renovations and all parties seem to be in agreement that this is acceptable. I agree as well.
- Change order to replace condenser units for the freezers and refrigerators. My understanding is that a subcontractor has agreed to not only replace the condensers as called for in the contract documents, but in addition subcontractor will replace coolant lines and other components. This will lead to a more thorough retrofit than originally called for and provide the owners with a better end product. This more comprehensive retrofit is only marginally more expensive than the allowance originally provided. I agree with the owner's representative that it is worth the added expense to do a better job.
- Change order to replace metal roofing at west side of adult detention center. It is my understanding that this portion of the work will replace a substandard existing metal roof with an insulated, properly sealed, metal roof that conforms more closely to the original design intent of the building. For reasons that are not exactly clear, this portion of the roof was not built as called for in the contract documents. I agree that it makes sense to correct this portion of the roof, especially considering the time and effort that is already going into correcting the much larger flat roof area. Details and specifications for this portion of the work shall be forthcoming.

This reflects the current status of pending change orders for this project. Once again, I reiterate that I am in agreement with each condition and would recommend that the Owner approve each item, as I believe it best for the overall completion of the project. Please let me know if there are any additional questions or comments.

EXISTING CONDITIONS:

Detention Center West Side Metal Roofs:

The existing metal roof is leaking and in a failing condition. The existing metal roof was installed directly over the metal deck without the required membrane underlayment as recommended by the **National Roofing Contractors Association**. Current leaks were most likely caused either by wind driven rain or a high volume of water running over the metal panel. The standing seam snap lock panel may not have been able to maintain a watertight seam with a high volume of water that will drain from the upper low slope roof during heavy rains or high winds that may have blown water behind the head flashing closures at the wall intersection. In either scenario, the leak would have been avoided if the roof system was installed with the proper underlayment. It was also noted that the roof was installed without roofing insulation which could lend itself to additional condensation issues that may or may not have been a noticeable issue in the past.

These observations are intended to provide a representation of conditions on the roof at the time of this inspection and shall not be construed as a warranty or other judgment as to the suitability of the roof to perform its intended function.



RECOMMENDATIONS:

Detention Center West Side Metal Roofs:

Tremco would recommend a full replacement of the existing metal roof. A full replacement would ensure the roof would be insulated bring it up to current code and would ensure a complete underlayment would be installed to prevent leaks in any senerio.

Scope of Work for full replacement:

1. Remove existing metal panels, gutter downspouts, and wall counter flashings down to the metal deck.
2. Mechanically fasten a 3" polyisocyanurate along with a ½" Dens Deck to the metal deck.
3. Provide additional wood blocking as necessary.
4. Dry in roofing insulations with Tremco POWERply SA Base Sheet.
5. Fabricate and install, of 24ga pre-finished metal, new perimeter edging, gutter and downspouts.
6. Fabricate and install of 24ga prefinished metal, new 16" wide double lock standing seam metal roof panels. Secure as required to meet wind requirements.
7. Install z-closures at hip and ridge along with counter flashing and surface mounted wall flashing.
8. Fabricate and install new conductor heads and downspouts from upper low slow roof to accommodate new metal roof heights.

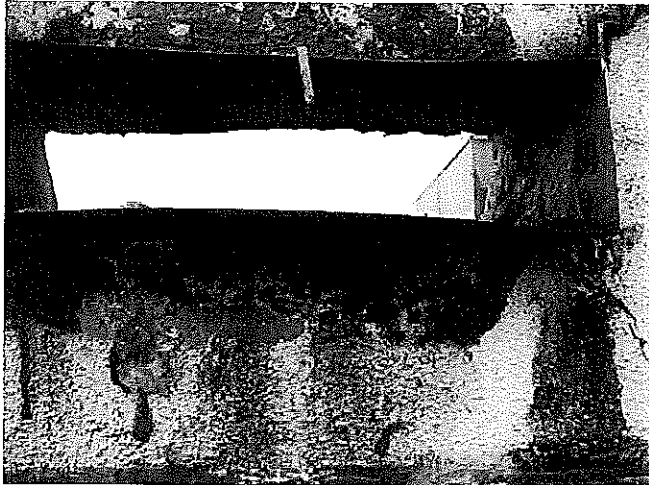

The cost for complete roof replacement as indicated above would be approximately \$ **88,000** to \$ **92,000**.

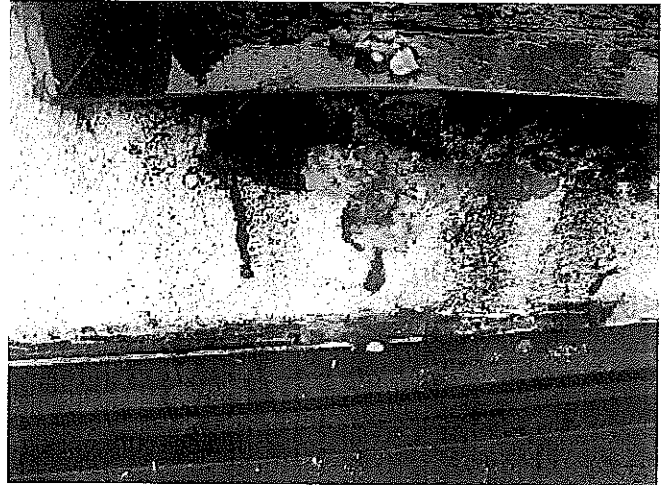

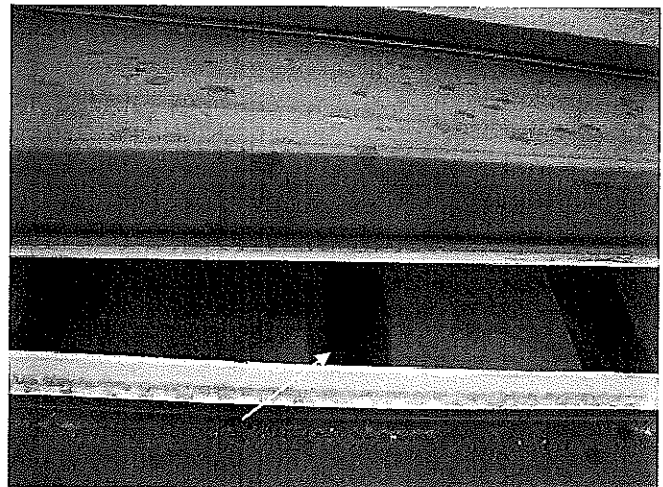
Sealant installed at entire perimeter of through wall scupper.



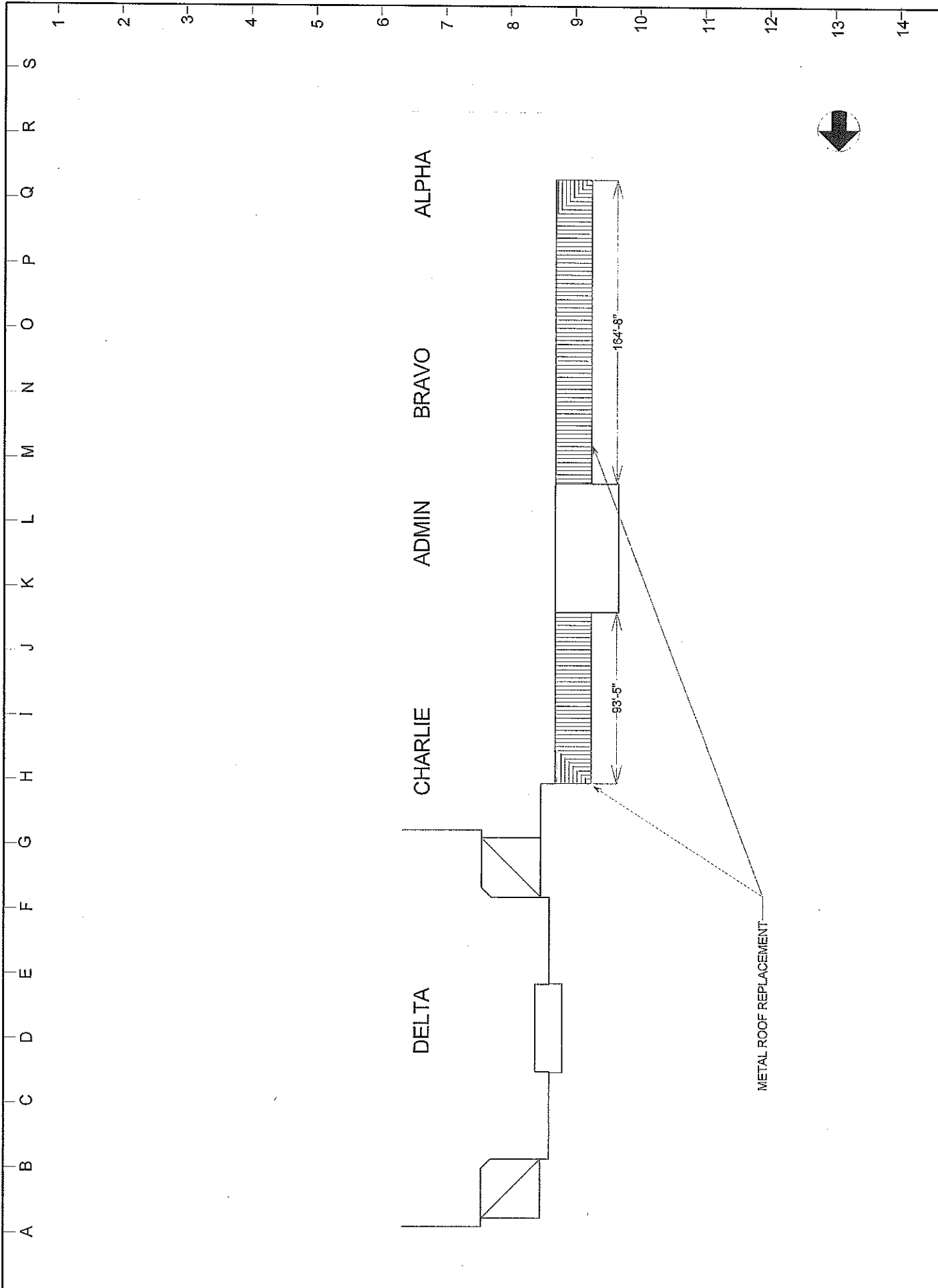
Sealant present at surface mounter counter flashing of metal roof.

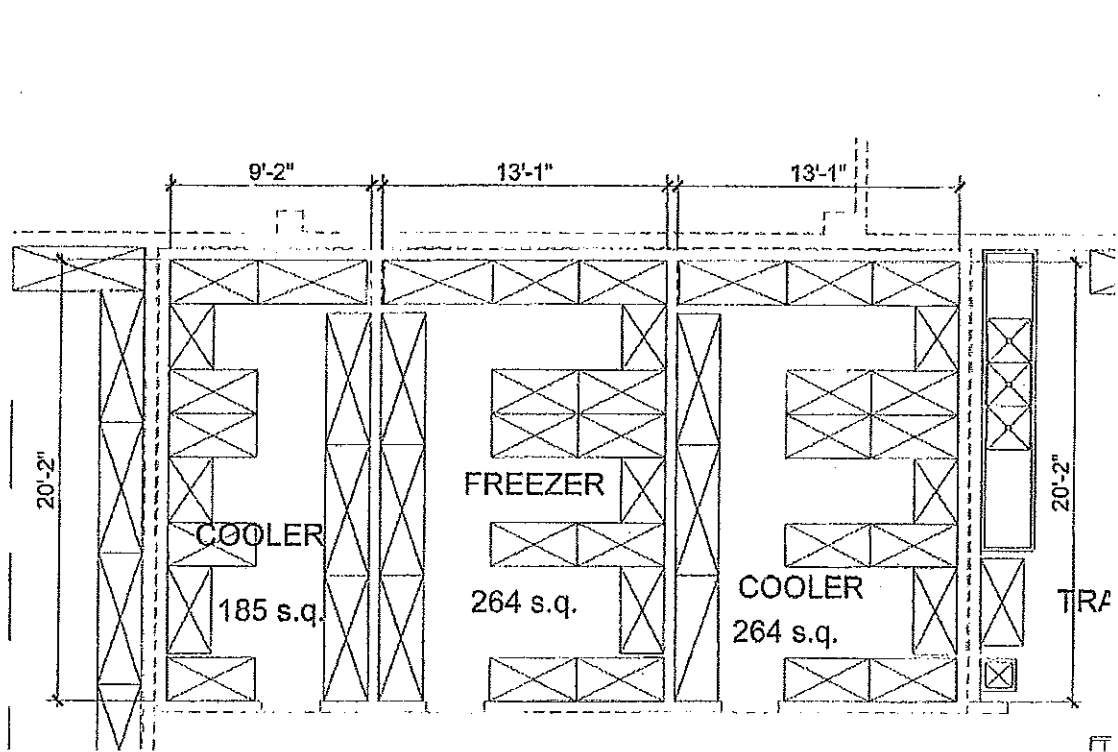
