
According to our records, the MSW Permits Section received a Request for Voluntary Revocation from you, on August 19, 2005. We responded on August 29, 2005, indicating that this type of request could only be granted after a closure inspection had been completed by regional office personnel.

On October 13, 2005, a facility inspection was conducted by Ms. Monica Galvan of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), Region 15, Office in Harlingen. A follow up report of this inspection declared that the requirements in Title 30 of the Texas Administrative Code (TAC), Section (§) 330.459 (relating to Closure Requirements for Municipal Solid Waste Storage and Processing Units) had been satisfied and that the site was prepared for closure.

Please submit an updated request for voluntary revocation of Permit No. 2102 within 30 days of the date of this letter, so that we can complete your revocation request.
