TxDOT concurs with Hidalgo County's decision to award a construction contract for its 3<sup>rd</sup>-call Border Colonia Access Program Competitive project in Delta West Subdivision (3C1080220) to the low bidder, 2GS, LLC. for a total bid of \$406,722.20.

My records indicate that the bid amounts for this competitive project exceed both drainage and roadway remaining fund amounts. As per BCAP program guidelines, TxDOT is only allowed to reimburse allowable expenditures up to the approved roadway cost per mile. In addition there is a 25% over-run cap on roadway expenditures. At this time, the remaining funds for this project are shown below:
