REQUEST FOR COUNTERDRUG SUPPORT

The mission of the Hidalgo County HIDTA Task Force (HCHTF) is to disrupt and dismantle through interdiction, investigation and prosecution of identified international, regional and local drug trafficking organizations including those individuals and or organizations currently utilizing county locations to facilitate illegal activities by storing, concealing and packaging narcotics and or narcotics proceeds for the sole purpose of continuing the criminal enterprise. Targeted illicit drugs include, but are not limited to, marijuana, cocaine, heroin, and methamphetamine. The mission is accomplished by enhancing and coordinating drug enforcement and asset identification and removal among federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies.

HCHTF is requesting analytical support (ICAS) personnel to assist with the research and collection of information on individuals and/or organizations involved in illegal activities. This position will analyze information; identify significant factors; and gather data from various secure information systems. After information is collected, this position will compile information to share the HCHTF investigators.

The period of assignment of the ICAS position to HCHTF will be at the discretion of the Texas Counterdrug Task Force Commanding Officer.
