### LCD Projectors:

The NEC NP-M282X is standard "square" format (4:3) projector offered at a great price. This projector displays a native resolution of 1024 X 768 pixels and will scale to 1600 X 1200 maximum.

The projector has a maximum lamp brightness of 2800 ANSI Lumens, weighs 7.7 pounds and has a 3 year limited warranty and 1 year lamp warranty. Inputs are VGA, HDMI and USB. (Cost Share Price = \$275) More information

The NEC NP-M323W is new generation "HD" format (16:9) projector. This projector display a native resolution of 1280 X 800 and a maximum of 1920 X 1200, matching the wide format and resolutions of current computer screens. The screen brightness is 3200 lumens, weight is 7.7 pounds and it has a 2 year warranty with a lamp warranty of 1 year or 500 hours, whichever comes first. The projector has VGA, HDMI direct inputs and also supports USB input and wired LAN inputs.

Wireless can be used with the purchase of an additional component. (Cost Share Price = \$325) More information

### Laserjet Printers:

For black and white moderate duty requirements, choose the HP Laserjet P3015dn with a rated speed of 35 pages per minute and has the duplex option that allows printing on both sides of the paper. This printer is network ready and compatible with stamps.com postage system. (Cost Share Price = \$350)  $\times 2 = \$700$

For light to moderate duty color laser requirements, choose the HP M553dn. Be careful when considering a color laser. They are more expensive to operate. This printer uses 4 cartridges, 3 colors and one Black. So you may want to consider adding a color laser only if you already have a good black and white printer. This printer does have the duplex option. This is a network ready printer. (Cost Share Price = \$360) More Information

### Scanner

We have the Fujitsu FI-7160 Document Scanner on this program. This is a high speed, high quality, sheet feed scanner. It is designed for conversion of paper documents to electronic format, but can scan single pages, photos and odd sizes. This model is compatible with the LaserFiche system and Windows 7. (Cost Share Price = \$450). More Information

The source of funds for the county share should be funds that are currently available. You will be billed when the orders are confirmed as shipped.

Also regarding source of funds, any local source is acceptable. The local source does not need to be the county government, but could be one of your local committees, a fair board, 4H Adult Leaders, or even a private individual who just wants to contribute something to Extension. Just be sure that when we send a bill to the address you give us, someone will pay it. This local source must fully understand, though, that the equipment is for use by you and your Extension office, not for them.

The exception to this local source rule is where you have funds in an Extension workshop account which have been generated through a local or county level Extension educational event, where registration fees were paid to Extension. Since these funds were locally generated, they are eligible for use in the cost share program. State appropriated fund accounts cannot be used. If you use an Extension Account you must put the account number on the order form.

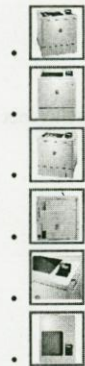

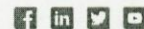
