The 2014 Operation Stonegarden performance grant period will end May 31, 2016. Total funding awarded to Hidalgo County under Operation Stonegarden 2014 was \$4,674,438.00. These funds were shared with seventeen (17) local law enforcement agencies which were invited to participate in 2014 Operation Stonegarden.

The La Joya Police Department was awarded \$100,000.00; however, they have not been spending their funds accordingly due to shortage of personnel. The Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office is respectfully requesting authorization to make the following changes in the funding in order to assist La Joya Police Department to expend their funds.

Sullivan City Police Department :

The Sullivan City Police Department was awarded \$100,000.00; however, they have not been spending their funds accordingly due to personnel issues. The Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office is respectfully requesting authorization to make the following changes in the funding in order to assist the Sullivan City Police Department to expend their funds.
