

HIDALGO COUNTY RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION OF THE HIDALGO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT ADOPTING THE HIDALGO COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION ACTION PLAN, MARCH 2016 ON BEHALF OF HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the County of Hidalgo has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the Hidalgo County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan, March 2016 in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Hidalgo County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan, March 2016 has been prepared in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44 C.F.R. 201.6; and

WHEREAS, the authority authorized by the Texas Disaster Act of 1975 relating to Emergency Management, specifically §418.106 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court Recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Hidalgo County; and

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan, March 2016 identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Denton County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, the following jurisdictions have signed resolutions adopting the Hidalgo County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan, March 2016; City of Alamo, City of Edcouch, City of Edinburg, City of Hidalgo, City of La Villa, City of McAllen, City of Mercedes, City of Mission, City of Palmview, City of Pharr, City of San Juan, City of Sullivan

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, by the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court that Hidalgo County adopts the Hidalgo County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan, March 2016 as this jurisdictions Multi-Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, and resolves to execute the action in the plan subject to available funding.
