Good afternoon, Eddie -- Mission Regional Medical Center is in the process of registering with HRSA (the federal government's Health Resources and Services Administration) seeking participation in the 340B discounted drug program. As a not-for-profit, disproportionate share hospital, we are eligible to participate in the program provided we meet several additional requirements. One of them is to certify that there is a valid contract in place between MRMC and "a State or Local Government Entity" to provide health care services to low income individuals who are not entitled to Medicare or Medicaid assistance. We believe this requirement is met by referencing the attached 1115 Waiver Affiliation Agreement with Hidalgo County.

I have also attached a pdf copy of the certification document that accompanies our on-line registration. As you'll see, there is a place for you to sign as the Local Government Official (just above your printed name). **Would you please sign and date the attached document (named "Untitled" above) and send a scanned copy back to me.** This is a required document in the registration process.

Eddie, if you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to give me a call, but I think this is simply a formal acknowledgement of the Affiliation Agreement that is already in place between MRMC and Hidalgo County.
