

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Hidalgo County that the **Equipment for Border Operations - ATV** be operated for the period of **September 1, 2016 through February 28, 2017**; and

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court understands that there is no matching fund requirement for the said project; and

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Regional Homeland Security & Criminal Justice – Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council funds, Hidalgo County assures that the funds will be returned to the Regional Homeland Security & Criminal Justice – Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council in full.

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court designates Hidalgo County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court approves submission of the grant application for the **Equipment for Border Operations - ATV** to the Regional Homeland Security & Criminal Justice – Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council.
