THE FASTEST WAY TO COMPLETE THE RENEWAL PROCESS is online at texasbar.com. Log in to "My Bar Page" to securely pay by credit card and make changes to your profile. If you choose to pay by check, follow Steps 1, 2 & 3 below and return your payment in the envelope provided or mail to the State Bar Membership Department, PO Box 12030, Austin, TX 78711-2030. Please make check payable to Clerk, Supreme Court.

STEP 1: Verify Membership Dues Statement Information

Review the information on the front and back of your Dues Statement. If all information is accurate and **no changes are needed**, detach the coupon below and return it with your check to the State Bar Membership Department.

STEP 2: Changing Your Demographics or Membership Options

To change your demographic information, complete Side 1 of the Change Form. To change your Section Memberships, Access to Justice (ATJ) Contribution amount, or to claim an exemption from the Legal Services Fee, complete Side 2 of the Change Form. You must specify all Sections which you wish to join or remain a member. Enter the new totals on the Change Form and return it with your check to the Membership Department. **If you are making changes, return only the Change Form and not the Dues Statement coupon.**

STEP 3: Changing Address Information

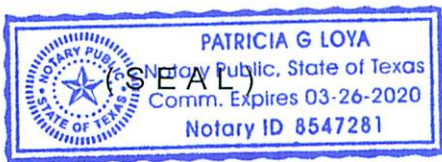

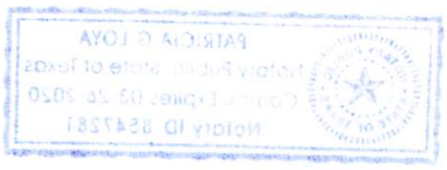
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
